There were no casualties as a result of a fire at Standard Products (Canada) Ltd. Wednesday after-

Firefighters were called to extinguish a blaze in the exhaust and fan system at the automotive parts plant located on Guelph Street, Georgetown.

The next day, the plant was twothirds in operation, according to Division Manager Carl Brundle. He said the plant would be completely back to normal by Monday.

Many passershy stopped to watch the black smoke pouring out of the exhaust stacks on top of the roof Wednesday.

The Halton Hills fire department responded with about 20 men at 3:55 p.m. with two pumper trucks, an aerial ladder truck and a rescue van. Police later arrived to keep traffic moving on Highway 7.

There were no injuries among the firefighers, said Deputy Chief Bob Hyde. The deputy chief suspects the fire began at the end of a conveyor

system and spread upward into the collector system.

The cause of the blaze is still under investigation and a full report has not yet been completed, said the deputy chief.

There was minimal damage and the fire never truly threatened the building, he said. Firefighters had no problem containing the flames because it was in the exhaust collection system. Water was applied through hatches in the exhaust

Firefighters checked the roof exhaust vents for further fire damage. Some of the blaze disintegrated on

its own said the deputy chief. Mr. Brundle said there was damage to the stacks and exhaust fans and some electrical work but he could not give a damage estimate yet.

Deputy Chief Hyde stressed that the fire department's report was not yet completed, but that he thought damage would be less than \$10,000.




