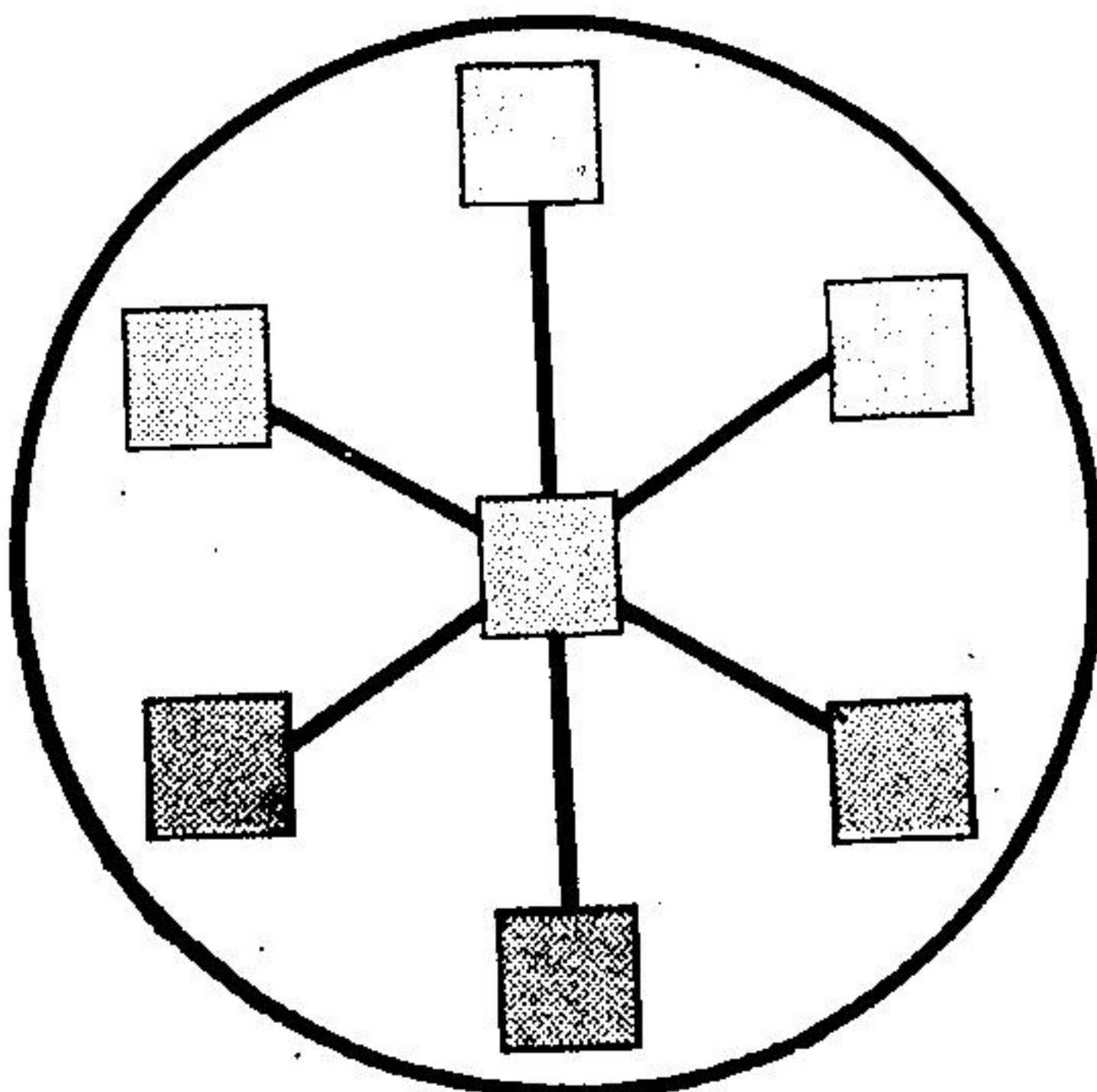

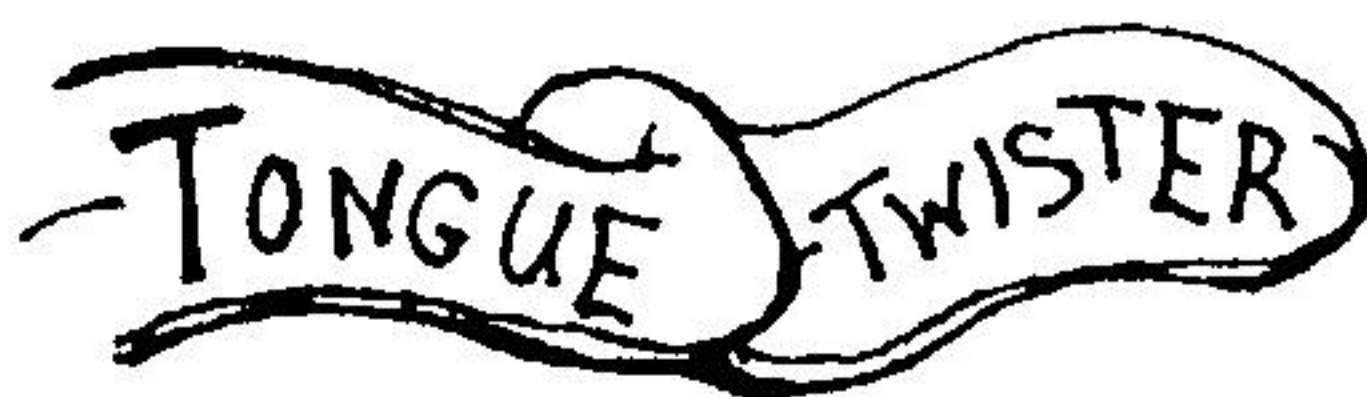
(Answer: Ireland)

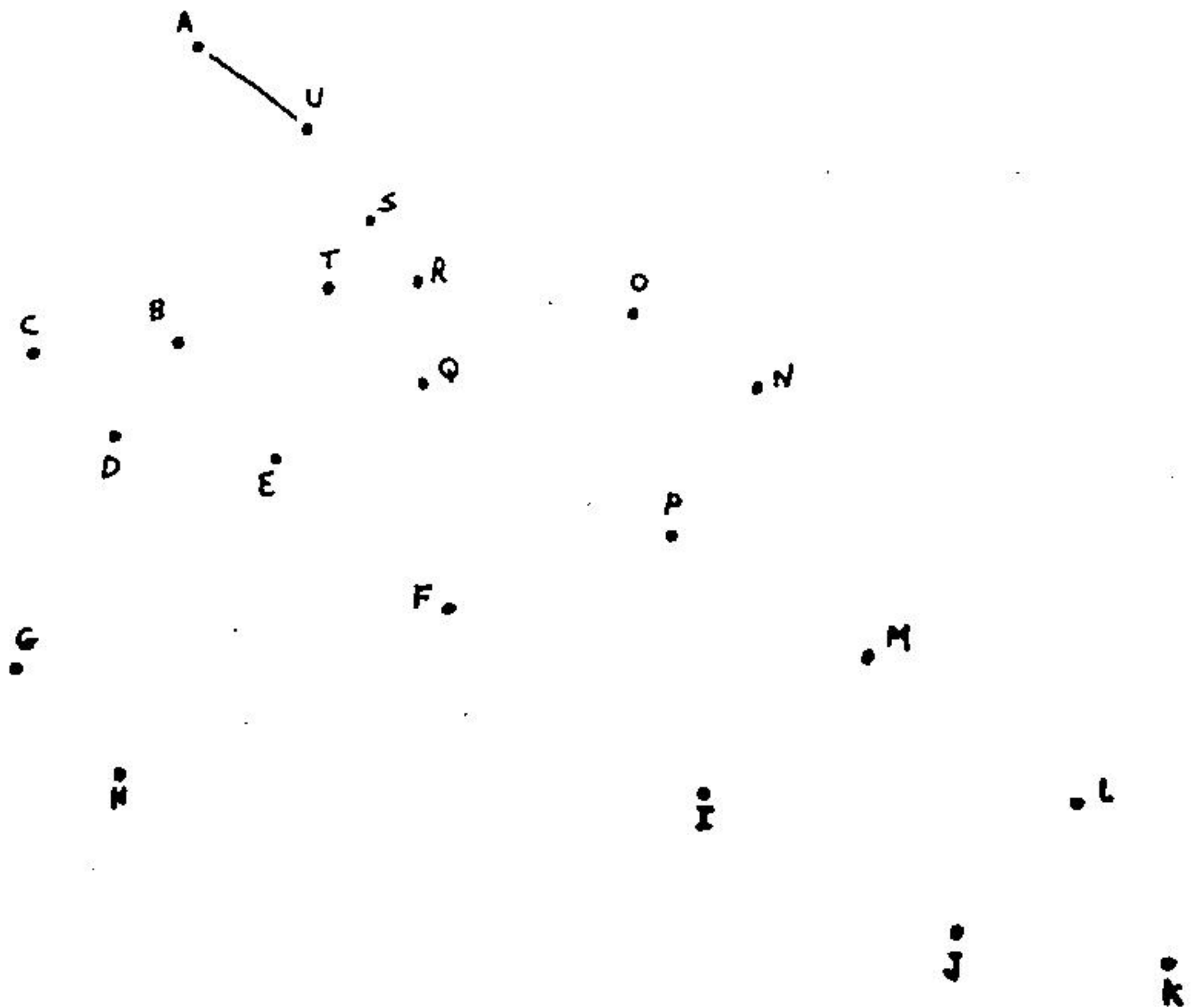

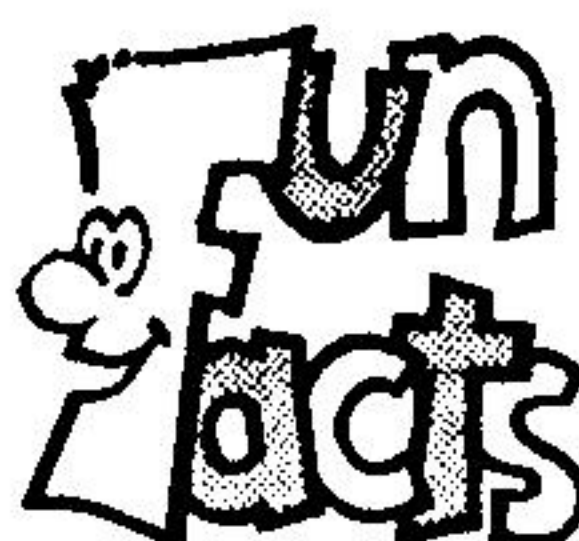
2. Most of the English people are descended from invaders who began settling in the area more than 2,500 years ago.
