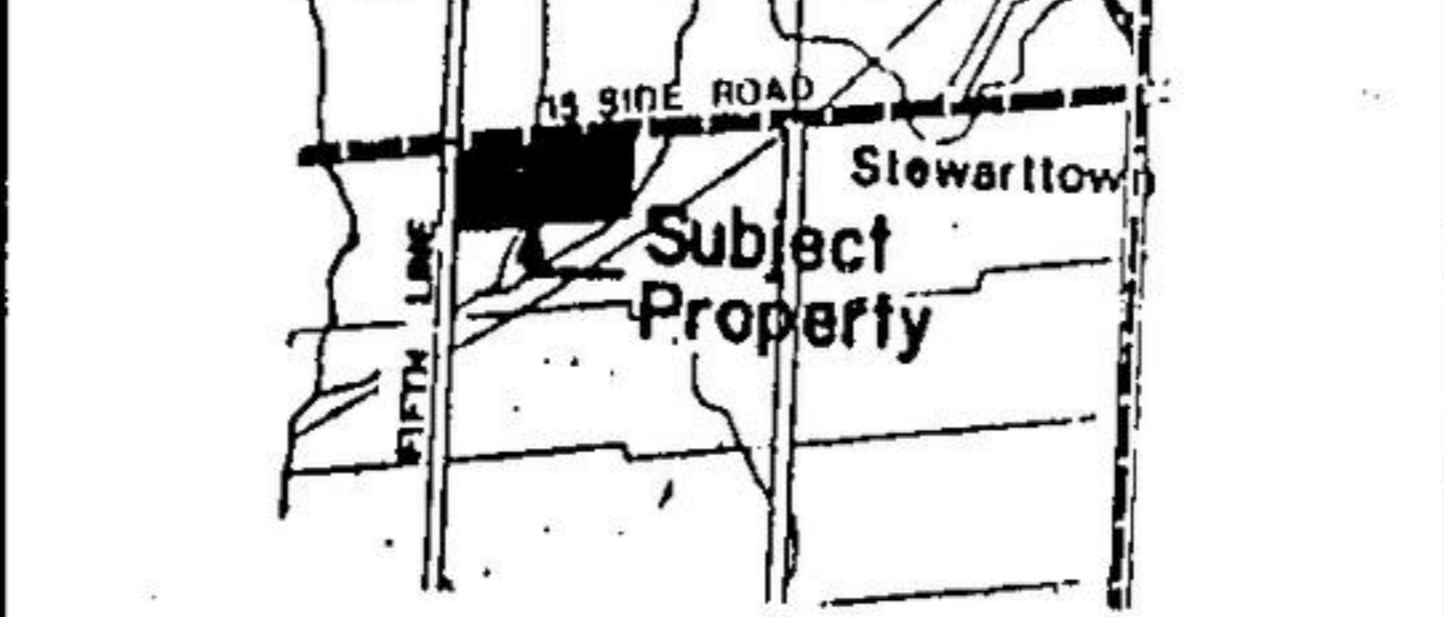

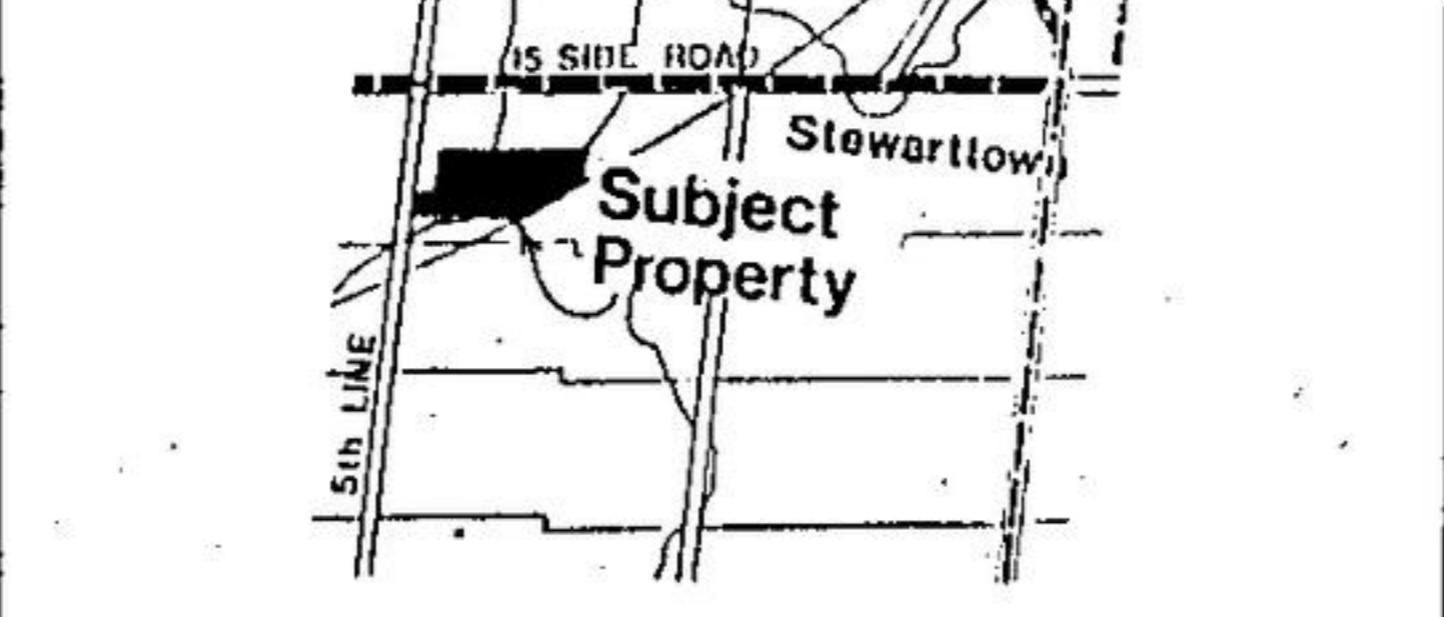

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DESIGNATE:

TAKE NOTICE THAT the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills intends to designate "CRAIGLEA", the home on the property described as part of the Northeast Half of Lot 9, Concession 3, (formerly of the Township of Esqueping) on the West side of the Third Line between the Fifth and Tenth Sideroads, as being of architectural and historical interest under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act.

REASON FOR DESIGNATION - "CRAIGLEA":

The house was built before 1861, of clapboard in the Classical Revival style. Architectural features of note include the main door frame, gabled roof, and window arrangements. Historically, the property is associated with the Stewart family and William Lyon MacKenzie who in 1837 addressed a crowd on the property.

Any person may, within thirty (30) days of the first publication of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Acting Clerk of the Town of Halton Hills, notice of his or her objection to the proposed designation together with the reasons for the objections and all relevant facts. If such a Notice is received, the Council for the Town of Halton Hills shall refer the matter to the Conservation Review Board for a hearing.

Form 2 EXPROPRIATIONS ACT NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL TO EXPROPRIATE LAND

IN THE MATTER OF an application by THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS (name of expropriating authority)

for approval to expropriate land being part of Lot 18, Concession 8, Town of Halton Hills, Regional Municipality of Halton, for the purpose of constructing a public road and for other public uses in conjunction with the construction of a municipal administration building.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows: An interest in the nature of a right-of-way or easement in, under and over that part of Lot 18, Concession 8, Town of Halton Hills, Regional Municipality of Halton, described as Part 2 on Reference Plan 20R-6472.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an inquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

(a) In the case of a registered owner, served personally or by registered mail within thirty days after he is served with the notice, or, when he is served by publication, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice; (b) In the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

NOTES:

- 1. The Expropriations Act provides that, (a) where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Attorney General; (b) the inquiry officer, (i) shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and (ii) may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith. 2. "owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows: "owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested; "registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper land registry or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll. 3. The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.
