

The smoke-free policy at Georgetown District High School prompts some students to walk out and form a blockade on Highway 7. Students felt the road sit in was the only way to be heard.


A local real estate manager said the Town of Halton Hills erred by selling 15 lots on Princess Anne Drive without first tendering the deal.
