## Students blockade to protest a policy

The smoke-free policy at Georgetown District High School prompts some students to walk out and form a blockade on Highway 7. Students felt the road sit-in was the only way to be heard.

The Dr. Jack Ford appeal hearing began in Toronto and testimony was heard about the doctor conducting a little less than five times more hysterectomies on women under 35 than staff at Women's College Hospital.

Plans for help in locating a video tape about coma victims was issued by Mary Franks. Her son, Paul, 20, was in an accident and she is looking for ways to rehabilitate him.

Town councillors put their unanimous stamp of approval on a \$6.1 million town municipal building.

### NOVEMBER

Town council has recommended draft approval for another 520 homes on the west side of Mountainview Road South.

A national postmasters union warns that rural post offices such as the Terra Cotta and Limehouse branches are in danger of closing due to cutbacks by Canada Post.

A group of residents has formed to oppose speeding vehicles, especially trucks. The trucks are heading to and from the United Aggregates quarry on the Fourth Line near Acton. The group was organized after a seven-year-old boy was hit by a truck after the student had disembarked from a school bus.

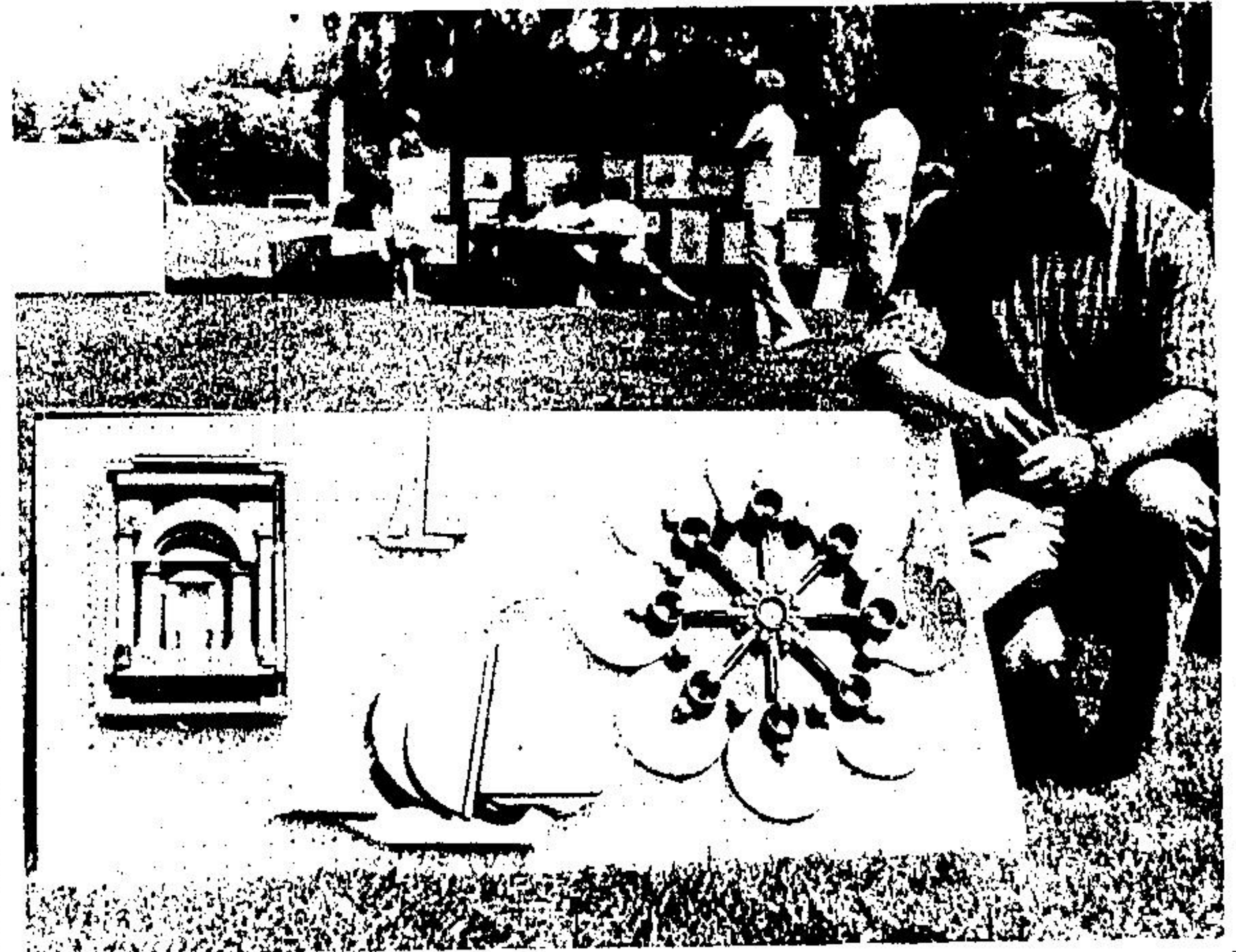
A local real estate manager said the Town of Halton Hills erred by selling 15 lots on Princess Anne Drive without first tendering the deal.

Orphaned Armenians who came to Canada at a young age and called the "Georgetown Boys" now have a movie about them. A film was unveiled in Toronto about the refugees who came to Georgetown and were raised at Cedarvale Park, then a farm.

Another movie is shot in downtown Georgetown called Almost Grown. The made-for-television movie was shot on Edith Street and Main Street, starring Timothy Daly.
