






A BONE FOR FIDO


If you were a dog and had to eat this bone, write how you would feel



your dog in your yard or on a leash. 4. Use flea spray or a flea collar to rid the dog of fleas.

5. Have a dry bed or area for the dog to sleep on.


BOOKS ABOUT DOGS
