## A diversified business base

Metropolitan Toronto's diversified business base will contribute to a growth-oriented commercial real estate market in 1988, reports the 1988 Royal LePage Market Survey.

While some forecasters predict a slowdown in certain sectors of the Ontario economy in 1988, Royal LePage researchers believe Toronto's commercial real estate market will maintain a relatively stable keel.

Royal LePage's computerized office data base forecasts that brisk leasing activity largely sourced from the private sector will result in absorption of 6.9 million sq. ft. by year-end 1988. The estimate for new supply in 1988 is approximately 7 million sq. ft.
