-Arrange for limousine service (if required). SIX WEEKS BEFORE THE WEDDING

-Have your final dress fittings.

-Purchase gifts for groom and attendants.
-Schedule rehearsal and rehearsal party. -Arrange accommodation for out-of-town guests.

-Start writing thank-you notes for any gifts received.
TWO WEEKS BEFORE THE WEDDING

-Plan for transportation to the church and reception for entire wedding party.

-Pick up wedding gown.

-Wrap the wedding cake. ONE WEEK BEFORE THE WEDDING

-Confirm all arrangements with florist, photographer, caterer and any other suppliers.

WEDDING DAY -Have your hair styled and makeup done.

-Be ready 11/2 hours before the ceremony for pictures.

-Leave for the church to arrive 5 minutes before the ceremony. -Take a deep breath and relax and enjoy your special day.


Romantic folklore that continues to delight
