



However, if they want to look around for some other homes in the same price range and think about it for a little while, we have a big problem on our hands. By the time they have made a decision, several other people have made the same decision, and the house is probably sold by then, or our buyer is then in competition with another offer, which gives them very little leverage on price. It is a very discouraging market for a buyer to work in and a market that I personally have nightmares in.

Buying a home is supposed to be fun! It is supposed to be in a relaxed manner and under circumstances where you can make well informed decisions, and be thrilled at finding your dream home. How can you do this when you are under the gun for time! It beats me, except that I know from a little of past experience, that the market will loosen up shortly. January and February seem to bring us this kind of market very frequently, and it gradually breaks by late spring, when all those people who are "waiting for spring," do get a For Sale sign on the lawn.

However, it is good news for those of you who can get that sign up earlier than you had perhaps planned on. Obviously, with the shortage of homes for sale, it is keeping the prices up, and you will sell faster and get a very good price for your home at present, provided that you have priced it realistically.

For those of you who are out there looking, take heart, don't panic over this market, it will change and you will find your dream home. Most of all, have faith in your agent to be on top of what is out there, and to advise you accordingly. Sanity will prevail again and you will make it through the next couple of months, provided you can keep smiling.
