## Lives destroyed at will?

Dear Sir.

when the Supreme Court of Canada made its fateful split decision to strike down Article 251 of the Criminal Code of Canada. The news, which reached me by transatlantic telephone filled me with dismay and apprehension.

First, I cannot help but ask why a matter of this importance was not heard by all nine Justices of the Supreme Court.

Second, I find it ironic that the argument to strike down this section was based in large measure on the Charter of Rights provision which guarantees "life, liberty and security of the person." The aborted baby certainly has no chance of ever enjoying life, liberty and security. Can the same argument, in time, justify the killing of an older sick person whose care in the home or in the hospital intrudes upon the "life, liberty and security of the person" of his partner of his children?
