Oakville Blades on verge of upset playoff win

The Oakville Blades may be in the process of staging an upset over the Streetsville Derbys in their best-of-seven Central Jr. B semifinal playoff series.

The Blades, after sweeping the Georgetown Gemini in their opening round of the playoffs, took a two games to none lead over the Derbys, with the third contest of the series to have been played Friday night in Oakville.

The Derbys finished second in the Central loop's West Division, four points ahead of the third place Blades.

In the other West Division semifinal match-up, the Burlington Cougars opened their best-of-seven set with a win over the Etobicoke Capitals.

Over in the East Division, the Barrie Colts received a scare from the Aurora Eagles, but held on to win Game 2 by a 10-9 margin, and take a 2-0 lead in the series Wednesday.

The other match-up had the Richmond Hill Dynes taking a 5-2 decision from the Vaughan Raiders Wednesday night and knotting their series at two games apiece. The fifth game in that series goes Sunday at Vaughan.
