40-week sales training for unemployed

Are you a woman who is receiving some type of social assistance, has been unemployed for at least three years, and is eligible to work in Canada?

In co-operation with Employment and Immigration Canada, along with Sheridan College, a sales training program is being offered by Dymar Management Consultants Inc. which is available at no cost.

It is a 40-week program starting in April that includes 19 weeks of training by highly qualified teachers from Sheridan College, and 21 weeks of on-the-job training with an employer. The Sales Training Program is a course consisting of three major sections: Life and Work Skills, Occupational Skills, and Job Search Skills.

Life and Work Skills, which takes up the first six weeks of the course, focuses mainly on developing confidence on the job. Instructors help develop effective communication skills, as well as solid decision-making and problem-solving skills. Women are also taught about equal pay and employment equity.

Occupational Skills teaches important elements of the sales field, gives valuable on-the-job training in a non-threatening environment, along with an update on the latest technology and future expectations. A certificate is awarded to all of the women who complete this section of the course in appreciation of Sheridan College and Dymar Management Consultants Inc.
