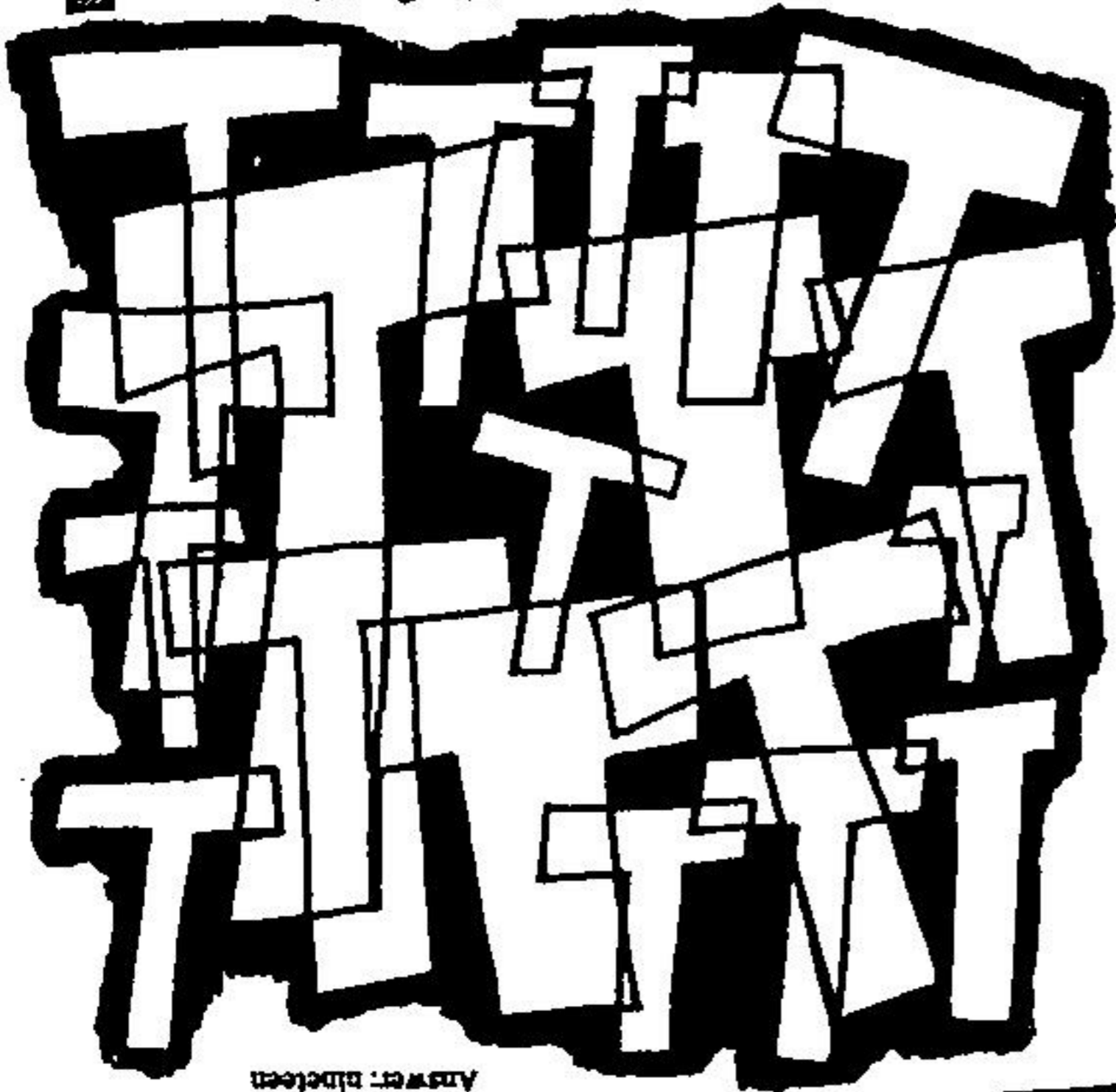

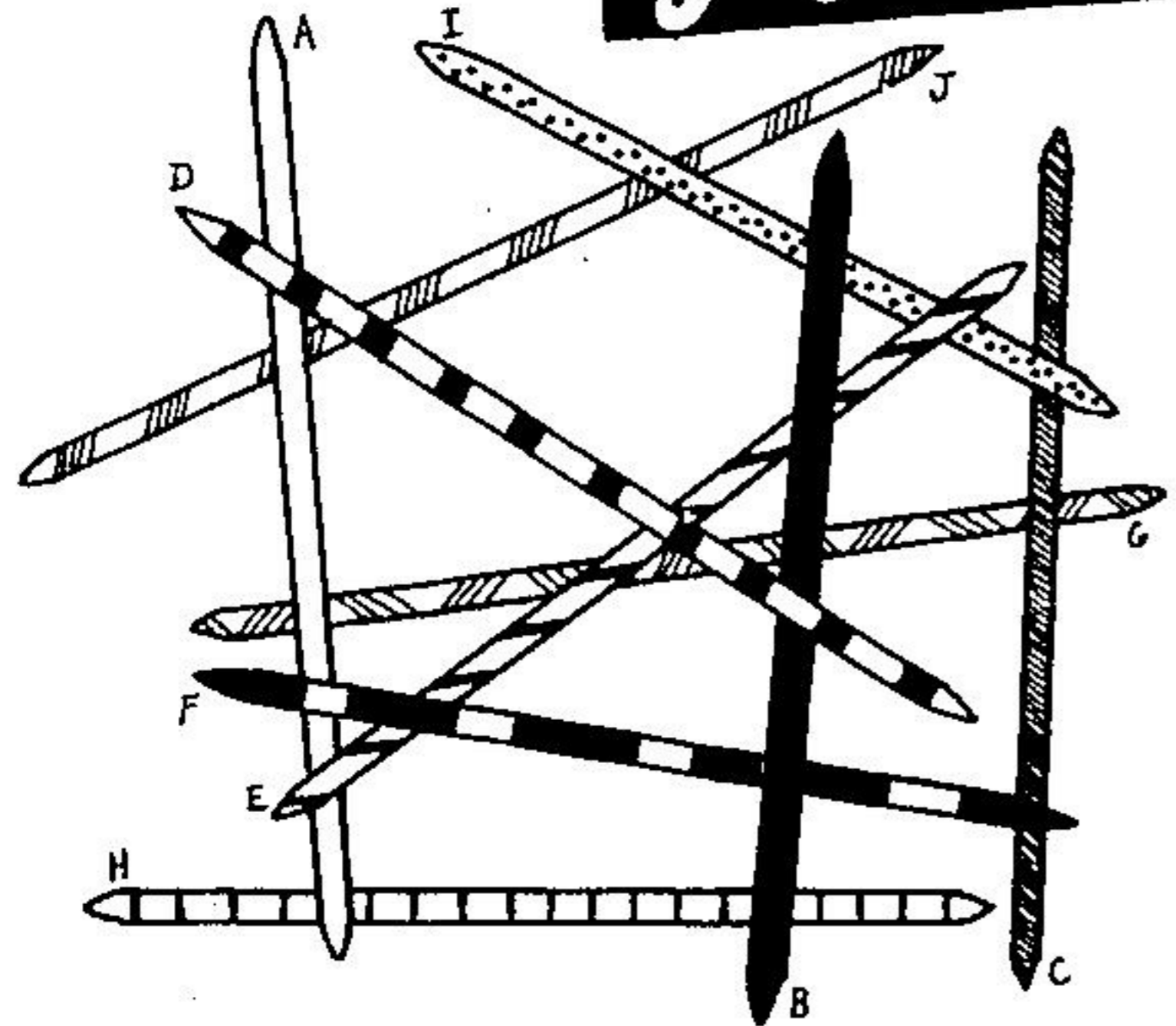
T-Time

Above is a list of five things produced by Tennessee. However, you have to provide the first three letters of each.

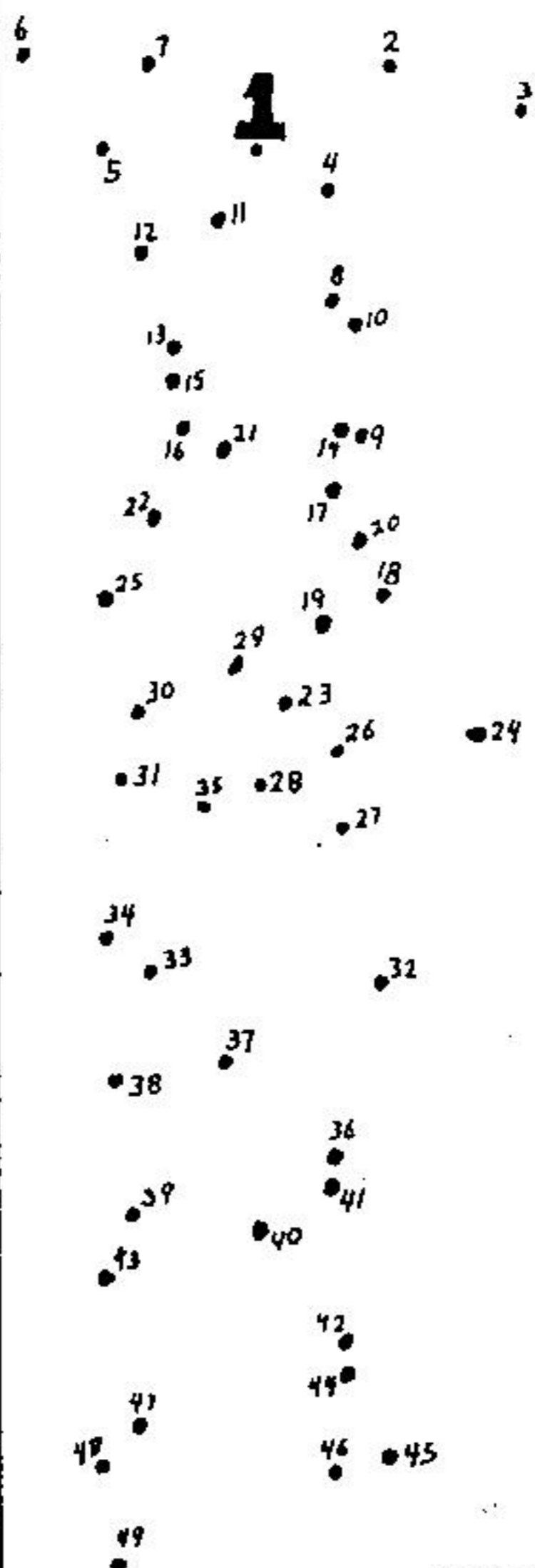

Davy Crockett (1786-1836) was a famous Tennessee frontiersman. In 1835, Davy left Tennessee to take part in the Texas War for Independence. On March 6, 1836, Davy and 184 other defenders were killed in the Mexican attack on the Alamo. Complete the picture of Davy and you'll have a picture to color.

Connect the dots, turn the page sideways, and you'll be able to read the name of a well-known Tennessean. This person was the 7th President of the U.S. and was a famous general who defeated the British in the Battle of New Orleans during the War of 1812.
