They specialize in the design, development and delivery of theatrical presentations based on educational themes. Professional puppetry today is no mere child's-play!

There will be two shows per day, one at 10 a.m. and one at 1:30 p.m., running approximately forty minutes each (including discussion period). Enthusiasm has been expressed by public schools to participate in this delightful event, and teachers will be booking tickets for their individual classes. For the general public, tickets will be sold AFTER APRIL 8. The price is \$2 each, and can be obtained in person at Royal LePage Real Estate (Guelph Street) during office hours (9-5 Monday to Friday, 9-5 Saturday), or at Georgetown and Acton Public Libraries.
