We estimate that 14,000 tickets have passed through Peggy's hands since she took over from Greta Lee Nicholas, Jo Heed and Joyce Holland. That's a lot of responsibility and a lot of hours for a volunteer to put in.

Lots of people ask if we get paid for our efforts at Georgetown Little Theatre and the answer is emphatically no. Many of us have jobs in the daytime and this is just an exciting hobby. Peggy Arcuri is no exception, having spent all her years in town as a teacher at Park School. She currently teaches Grade 1 and has done so for the past six years.

The Arcuri family is theatrically minded. Peggy's husband, Ed, who is a guidance counsellor at R.H. Logerquist Senior Public School in Heart Lake, was first to get the bug 18 years ago. Ed played the doctor in Blithe Spirit three years ago and we have been trying to get him back on stage since then.

Peggy joined him in 1976, working on props, front of house and even co-directing a play. The Arcuris have two children, Stacy and Mark, who both live in town. Stacy is carrying on the family tradition and has been in several GLT productions, most recently in Ten Little Indians last spring.

Peggy says she has thoroughly enjoyed her duties at GLT's box office and is ready to help out at the theatre during performances. She

also hopes to free up some time to pursue her golfing hobby.
