

GEORGETOWN DOCTORS IN 1850's

The first doctor in Georgetown was Dr. Nathaniel Bell. In the early 1800's there were only 3 qualified doctors from Hamilton to Toronto.

Dr. Bell had been an assistant surgeon in the 1812 war and was shot in the leg. He had married twice and had nine children by his first wife, and 5 by his second. He died Oct. 26 1859 at 69 years of age, leaving his family poor as he never pressed for his fees. He reached his patients by horse and treated such diseases as diptheria, small pox, typhoid, cholera and appendicitis (then known as "inflamation of the bowels") and often resulted in an agonizing death,
