Kevin Costner and James Earl Jones have been signed as the stars for a movie that will be based on Canadian novelist W.P. Kinsella's tale of a ghostly return by Shoeless Joe Jackson.

Shocless Joe was one of the Chicago White Sox players kicked out of major league baseball after an investigation into what came to be known as the Black Sox scandal. The probe indicated members of the White Sox threw the 1919 World Series to the Cincinnati Reds on the orders of gamblers.

Kinsella's vivid novel brought Shoeless Joe back for a ghostly ball game. Can a movie script keep pace with Kinsella's imagination?


