## Landscaping project proceeds

Halton Region will go ahead with landscaping behind Regan Crescent despite skyrocketing costs.

Halton had set aside \$175,000 for landscaping behind Regan Crescent as a provision of the expansion of the Georgetown Sewage Plant. The Region wanted to construct a berm and plant trees for screening behind the houses so residents wouldn't have a direct sight line to the bigger sewage plant.

But Halton had to speed up the design and tendering process in the fall to meet deadline requirements for expansion of the sewage plant for Enterac Development Corporation.

Rather than have an estimate for the landscaping submitted, contractors were given the \$175,000 allowance to incorporate into the tenders.

But estimates for the project came in at almost \$600,000.

The increased costs were due to construction, then removal of an access road of Metcalf Court for large trucks as well as other costs not included in the original estimate.

Region staff came up with a plan, which would cost an estimated \$321,000 and would still satisfy the residents of Regan Crescent, said Halton's Commissioner of Public Works Robert Moore.

The competitive nature of the tender process may reduce that cost even further, said Mr. Moore.

After meeting with a representative of the Regan Crescent residents Halton will now use first floor window height instead of second floor height to determine the height of the screening necessary, said Mr. Moore.

Tenders have now been called for the work, said Mr. Moore.

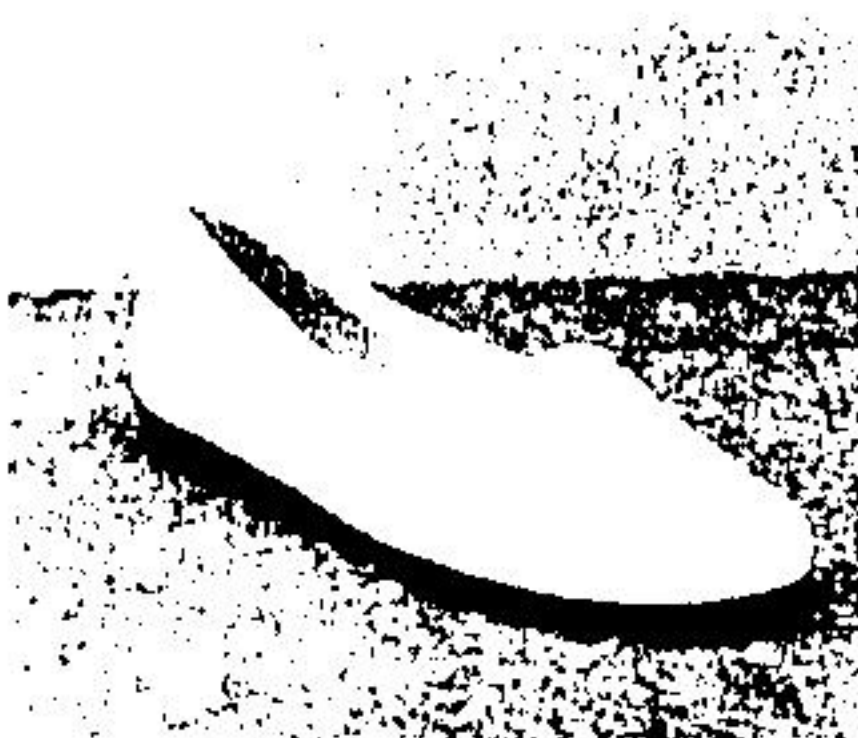
