Organizers for the BIG Chill Dance are asking people attending the event to make arrangements to be dropped off at the Memorial Arena, since there will be inadequate parking facilities for everyone.

The "Jack Baker Express" shuttlebus service will be leaving the arena at 10 p.m., 11 p.m., midnight, and 1 a.m., and will make a wide loop throughout Georgetown, so revellers can be dropped off close to their homes.

The bus will make stops at Moore Park Plaza, and then travel along Main Street, to Maple Street. From Maple, the bus will proceed north to Delrex Boulevard, and then east along the entire length of Delrex, to emerge at Guelph Street.

From there, it will travel along Guelph Street (Highway 7) to the Zellers parking lot. It will then continue along Mountainview Road north to John Street, and return to Memorial Arena.

Dance goers will have the opportunity to win a gas barbecue, courtesy of Georgetown Home Hardware, or a painting by local artist Linda Donais, framed by the Framing Centre.

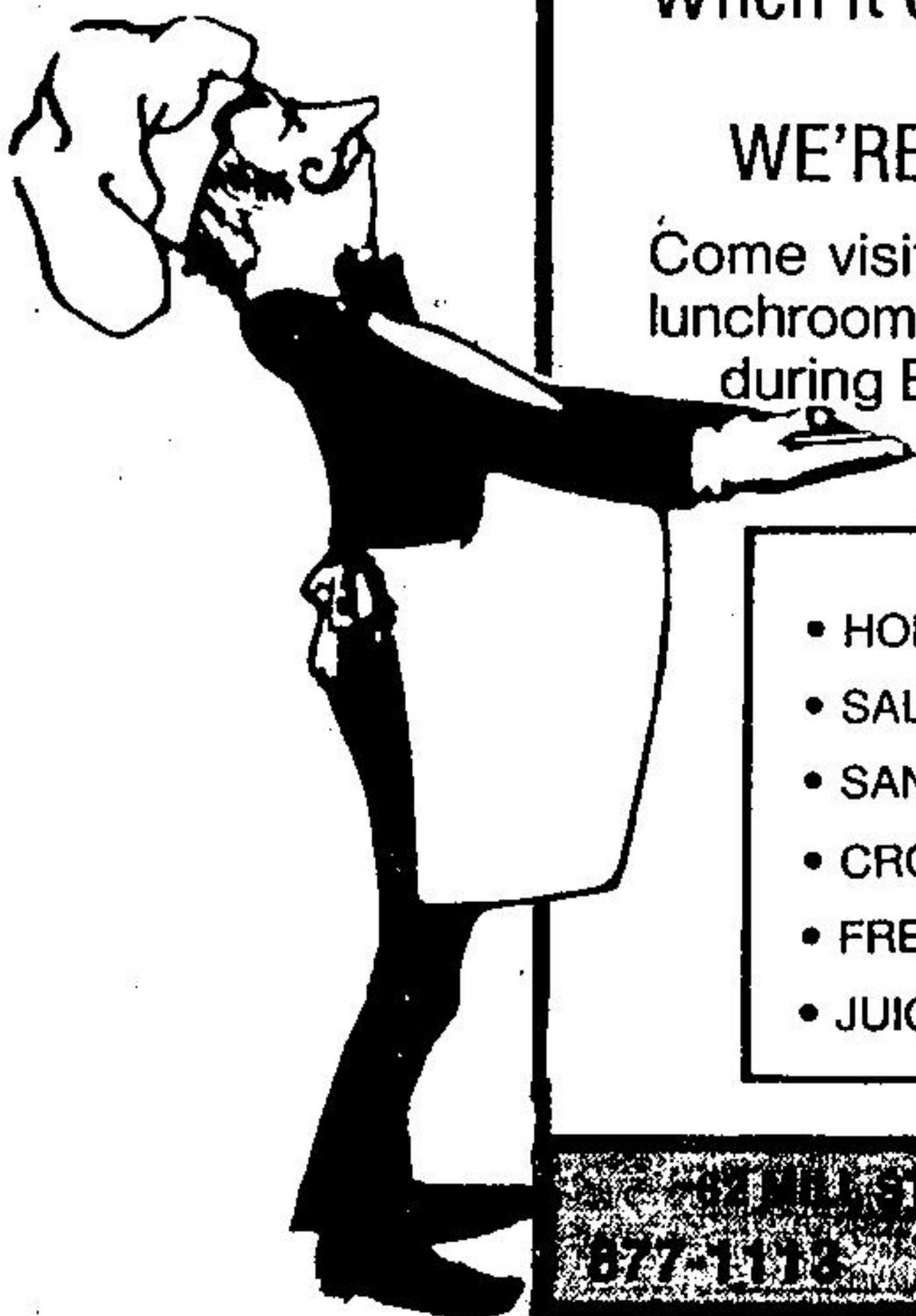
