## at Sheridan

Sheridan College Early Childhood Education Department (School of Applied Arts, Oakville Campus) is offering toddler and preschool programs at the Oakville Campus this summer.

The Toddler program is for children 2-3 years of age and is offered in three two-week sessions. Session I runs from July 4 - July 15 and the cost is \$100; Session 2 runs from July 18 - July 29 and the cost is \$100; Session 3 runs from August 2 -August 12 and the cost is \$90. The Toddler program runs from 9 a.m. -11:30 a.m. Monday-Friday, and the staff: child ratio is 1:4.

The Preschool program is designed for children 3-5 years of age, and runs from 9 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. Monday-Friday. The program is offered in one two-week session and four one-week sessions.
