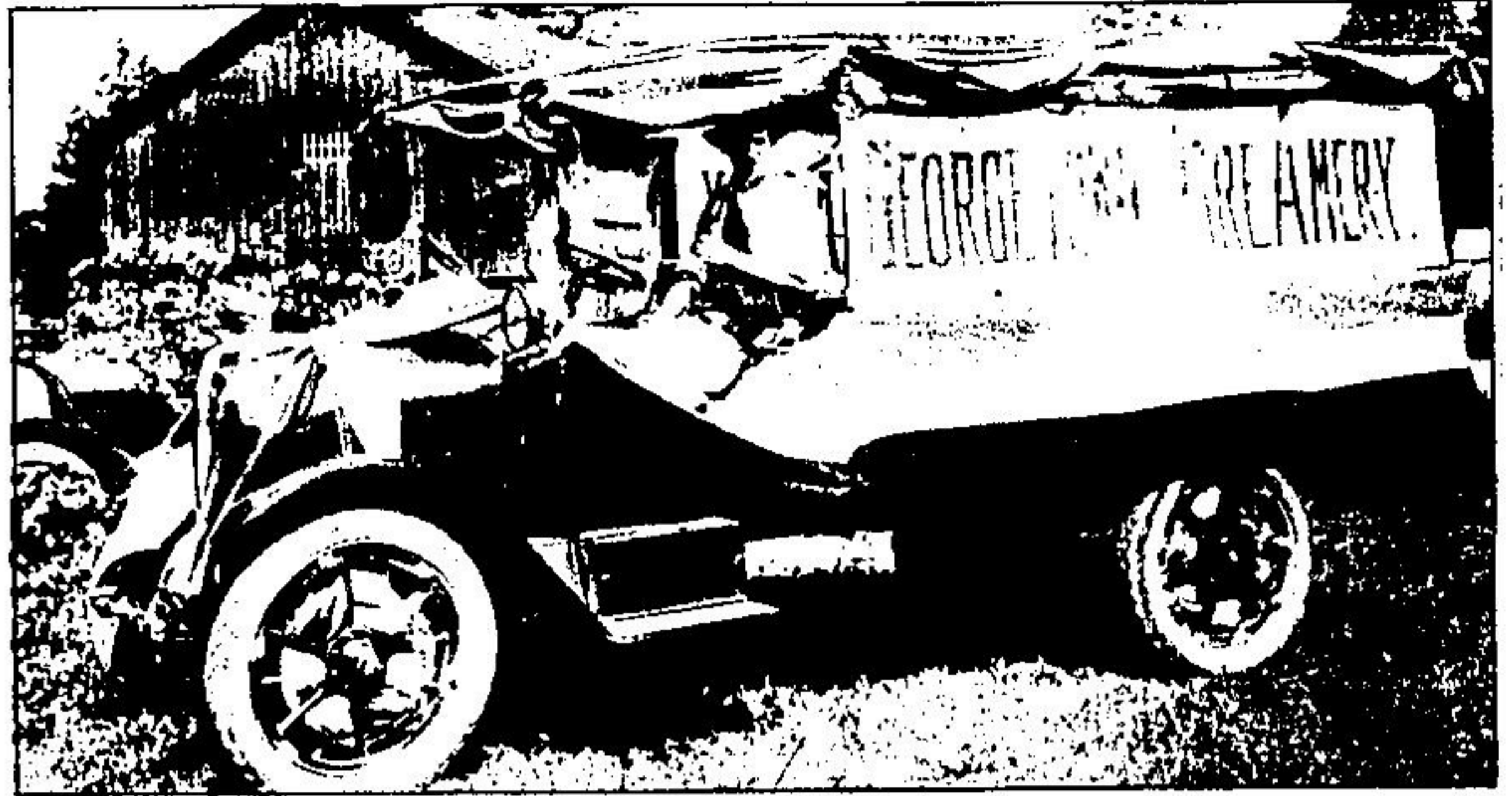

Plan to attend the garden party

The 60 acres of Dominion Seed House can be considered an oasis, amid the surroundings of urban advancement, so what better place for a garden party.

On Saturday, June 18, the Halton Hills Unit of the Canadian Cancer Society will present Symphony and Strawberries, using the facilities of Dominion Seed House as a very fitting location.

There will be a number of events held, beginning at 10 a.m. and running until late afternoon.

The Halton Youth Symphony will perform, and the Ukrainian Sheuchenko Musical Ensemble will also be there to entertain. The Ukrainian group features a chorus, mandolin orchestra, and dancers.

Radio and TV personality John Bradshaw, who is also an internationally famous horticulturist will be on hand at 11 a.m., and Art Drysdale, CFRB's gardening personality will be there at 2 p.m.

As well, there will be displays of antiques, crafts, and many demonstrations.

And there couldn't be a better setting for the event, either.

There will be walking tours of the Dominion Seed House grounds, and a total of six acres of Peonies will be at their very best to brighten up the day.

Admission for the day is \$3 for adults, and \$1.50 for teenagers, while children 12-years-old and under are admitted free when accompanied by an adult.

Proceeds from the day will go towards the Halton Hills Unit of the Canadian Cancer Society.
