The original Pledge of Allegiance was first published in the September 8, 1892 issue of the Youth's Companion, a weekly magazine, then published in Boston, Massachusetts.


The first people to live in America came from Siberia. These were Indians.

On August 21, 1959, President Eisenhower proclaimed Hawaji the fiftieth state of the Union and ordered a new arrangement of stars and stripes on the flag: five rows with six stars and four rows with five stars. This new flag was first raised on July 4, 1960. The Fourth of July is the time when all such changes in the flag's arrangment become official.

The 13 stripes on the American flag symbolize the 13 original states.







