Purpose and Effect

Interim Control By-law 38-86, as amended, was passed to restrict the permitted uses in the Agricultural "A" zone section of Zoning By-law 9-74 for a specific period of time.

During this time, Council undertook a comprehensive review of By-law 9-74, a process which ultimately resulted in the passage of Bylaw 22-88 on April 19, 1988.

By-law 22-88 is a new comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Township which consolidates previous zoning amendments; updates certain-provisions and regulations and includes metric measurements. Having therefore fulfilled the mandate of the Interim Control By-laws and replaced the previous comprehensive Zoning By-law it was appropriate to repeal By-laws 38p86 and 9-74.
