## Think about next year

Well, summer is in full swing, and for many, school is the last thing on your mind. However, July is fast approaching an end, and that leaves only August left for everyone's enjoyment.

Over the past eight weeks, we have provided some general information on summer job search techniques. We now are faced with reality - the summer of '88 is winding down for Angela and Karen at the Canada Employment Centre for Students. Our office will be closing the week of Aug. 8 and as a result this is our final column to you for the summer.

This summer we hope, through the Student Job Scene columns that you, as students, have been educated about finding summer employment. To help you further, we would like to suggest some tips about looking for work next summer.

Begin your summer job search early. Do not wait for school to end. Good summer jobs, that provide valuable work experience, are often filled in April shortly after March Break.

When you begin searching for a summer job, be prepared. Have your resume and work history sheet updated. Get permission from any references you may want to use and always have a Social Insurance Number available. If you need a Social Insurance Number, applications can be picked up from the Canada Employment Centre in Georgetown - apply early, it usually takes six weeks to receive a social insurance card.

Keep all job opportunities open - ask friends and relatives about any and all job possibilities. When applying for a job of any type remember to find out who you should contact.

The Canada Employment Centre can also help with your summer job search. Both federal and provincial governments usually hire their staff early in the year, and often have a deadline for various programs. The Summer Experience '88 program for this year had an application deadline in mid-April, and it will probably be similar for next year's programming. Information booklets regarding provincial summer jobs are available at the Canada Employment Centre.

If you have a desire to work at a camp or resort, do not leave it too late. Apply directly to the camp you are interested in, asking them to mail you an information package and application form. After receiving this, return it as soon as possible. Most camps want their staff hired early, so do not postpone returning it.

We realize it is hard to think of summer being over, and once school starts it is hard to imagine looking for next year's summer job. However, if you do not want to be left without a job for the summer, or working at a job that you don't particularly like, apply early and find employment that will provide you with a chance to have a challenging and exciting summer of 1989.

## Hydro ups some fees

Ontario Hydro's electrical inspection fees will be increased by 10 per cent starting Oct. 1, 1988. The increase is the first in three years.

"Fees for our electrical inspection service have not been raised since January, 1985," said Hydro's Manager of Electrical Inspection, Jack Dicker. "Hydro has been able to postpone fee increases since then because of improved productivity. The 10 per cent increase this year will allow us to improve service and meet rising costs due to inflation."

The new fees affect inspections for all residential, commercial and industrial installations. The cost to inspect a typical single family residence will go up about \$6 to \$70 under the new fee structure.

"Inspections are required under the Electrical Safety Code for all work on electrical installations,"

Mr. Dicker said. "Inspection is necessary to ensure the safety of the public and the proper operation of electrical equipment."
