

Moral: In the real world, as in medicine, timing and a good agent are of the essence.

DEAR DR. GOTT: Every day, I take Cardizem Isosorbide, Lasix, Slow-K, Nitro-Bid cintment, Nitrogard Buccal tab, Nitrostat Sub and Proventii - a total of about 22 pills daily. What is the best way for me to cut down on my pill taking?

DEAR READER: Sit down and talk with your doctor about reducing your medicines. You are taking too much. I am not being presumptuous in making this statement: Some of your drugs are duplicates. For instance, isosorbide, Nitro-Bid and Nitrostat ure all similiar nitroglycerine preparations - Nitrogard is, too, probably, but I can't find a reference for It. Therefore, four of your drugs could be combined into a single preparation, cutting down the amount by three. Proventyl is for asthma. Unless you have asthma, you may not need it. Heart failure can often mimic asthma, so your doctor may want to address that issue as well.

From the limited information you provide, I'd guess that you require Cardizem (a calcium-blocker to aid heart function), Lasix (a diuretic), Slow-K (to replace potassium losses from Lasix) and nitroglycerine (either in patch, ointment or pill form). Again, discuss this with your doctor; don't discontinue any medication on your own.
