Every year at the Georgetown Fair Sunday is "Children's Day." Events and attractions are scheduled that will be sure to keep the young (and the young at heart) entertained for the whole afternoon.

This year's Fair organizers have gone all out to provide the best Children's Day fun yet, with ongoing entertainment from noon to 5 p.m.

New to the Fair this year are two fun and exciting acts for the whole family. "Air Fantasy" uses the trampoline and comedy to present a thrilling, theatrical display of constant action combining dance with aerial maneuvers and stunt falls all choreographed to music. Fairgoers will be able to catch the action of Air Fantasy several times throughout the afternoon on Sunday.



The "Sphere Clown Band" is a Juno nominated group which features musical skills, sing a longs and slapstick comedy. Band members Bumpy, Patty, Banger and Gizmo have performed throughout Canada and the U.S. since 1977.

Past performances have included 5 seasons at Ontario Place, Roy Thomson Hall, Stratford Festival Theatre and C.B.C. and Global T.V. The Troupe does a lot of school shows where they are able to teach values and safety rules within the framework of this unique show.

Back for a second year at the Fair is magician Glenn Ot-taway. Kids of all ages were alternately amused and amazed during the magician's fantastic show last year on Children's Day. A must-see for all lovers of magic and humour.

Also new to the Fair this year is a Kiddie's Pedal Tractor Pull. There will be five classes of contestants in different weight classes. Children entering will be given three chances to get the sled moving from the starting line, keeping the pedal tractor between the pulling lines at all times. Both boys and girls 12 years old and under are eligible to enter.

Ongoing entertainment on Children's Day features many of Georgetown's own young people performing in the Centennial Alumni Choir, Cheri Lindsay's Jazz School and the first ever Middle School Air Band Competition.

Kids, do you have a pet that is aging well, has a moustache, wears glasses and looks like Tom Selleck? If so, then you could be the winner of the pet most resembling the Fair President at this year's Pet Show. There are several categories open for both dogs and cats - see you at the show!

### GEORGETOWN FALL FAIR KIDDIES' PEDAL TRACTOR PULL

#### — RULES AND REGULATIONS —

1. The contestant must be able to pedal the tractor without assistance.
2. Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants.
3. All contestants must wear shoes.
4. All contestants will be given three (3) chances to get the sled moving from the starting line.
5. The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of pulling lane at all times.
6. If the tractor leaves the pulling lane, the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crossed the boundary.
7. In case of a tie there will be a pull off to determine the winner.
8. There will be five (5) classes of contestants, they are:

CLASS - 1	30-40 POUNDS
CLASS - 2	41-50 POUNDS
CLASS - 3	51-60 POUNDS
CLASS - 4	61-75 POUNDS
CLASS - 5	76-90 POUNDS

9. Both boys and girls are eligible to enter, age limit twelve (12) years, not exceeding ninety (90) pounds.
10. The Judge's decision will be final for all pulls.
11. All contestants must be present by the time of pedal pull with signed permission slip in hand. The required signature of parent or guardian releases the Georgetown Agricultural Society from any financial responsibility due to accident.
12. Registration for the tractor pull will be one hour (12:30 p.m.) before pull time.
13. Participation limited, first come first served. CHILD MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT OR GUARDIAN AT TIME OF REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION.
