## McGowan returns to normal life

After serving as swim co-ordinator for Vicki Keith's historical crossings of the Great Lakes, Georgetown's Drew McGowan is now looking forward to returning to "normal life."

Over the course of the summer, Ms. Keith successfully swam across all five Great Lakes, and in doing so, raised a considerable sum of money for Variety Village.

"Vicki's goal was three hundred thousand dollars, and now we're at three-and-a-quarter. We exceeded (our goal) a little bit," Mr. McGowan said Monday.

Serving as Ms. Keith's sidekick, Mr. McGowan was very visible to the television cameras each time the swimmer stepped from the water after completing the five stages of the marathon. For the last several weeks Ms. Keith has been in and out of the McGowan family home in

Georgetown between crossings of Lakes Superior and Ontario.

When asked if he plans to make a habit of co-ordinating programs for other marathon swimmers, Mr. McGowan laughed, and said he intends to continue the pursuit of a career in the legal profession, despite his love for swimming.

During her hours thrashing on Lake Ontario, Vicki broke her own record for swimming the butterfly stroke, one of the most difficult strokes, and beat the former women's record, said Mr. McGowan.

"About four summers ago, she swam 12 miles butterfly and it took her 12 hours to finish." This summer, she swam 24 miles butterfly style in 17 hours, and 12 miles butterfly in six hours. "She doubled the

world record," said Mr. McGowan, Vicki Keith was met on shore after her Lake Ontario swim, the final leg of her marathon, by Variety Village chairman Wade Hampton and 20 children in wheelchairs, in addition to the throngs of people lining the Toronto beach.

"It was a touching moment when Wade Hampton greeted her," said Mr. McGowan. Vicki brought attention to the cause of Variety Village, particularly contributing to the aquatic wing of the Scarborough athletic complex for the disabled.

Next summer, Vicki has plans to swim international waters, said Mr. McGowan, but nothing has been con-

For now, Vicki will make speaking appearances and "relax" for awhile, savoring her success, said Mr. McGowan,

"We couldn't have asked for anything better. Vicki not only met her goal nationally, but has conquered all five Great Lakes," he


