Fun Facts

1. When the weather turns cooler in the fall, the veins in the leaf, which once brought water to it, become blocked. This causes the

chlorophyll to break down and stop its job of keeping the leaf green.

2. The color that a leaf turns in autumn depends on the hidden pigment, or coloring matter, present in the leaf: xanthophyll, for the yellows; carotene for the oranges; and anthocyanin, for the reds and purples.
