Duck population down

Hunting restrictions in effect

This summer's drought, while seriously affecting farmers' crops, has also depleted the "puddle duck" population, causing the Canadian government to restrict hunting privileges.

Puddle ducks (those that survive in shallow water as opposed to diving ducks who swim in deeper water) are being protected by Environment Canada, which has introduced a shorter hunting season and a smaller number of "daily bag" and possession limits for hunters.

Jim Sheldon, a hunter and a member of the preservation group Ducks Unlimited, says the Environment Canada decision was "a good move."

"The number of young ducks able to survive this year is much smaller (than last year)," he said. Part of the reason for a depleted duck population lies in the dangers inherent to shallower ponds.

The pond on Jim Sheldon's property this summer was dry enough for his dog to walk across, he said. And raccoons were literally treated to "sitting ducks," said Mr. Sheldon. "The raccoons were able to clear out quite a number," he said.

In Ontario, three types of ducks are being particularly protected: the black duck - a duck described by Mr. Sheldon as similar to a Mallard - the canvasback, and its look-alike, the redhead duck.

The hunting season in southern Ontario will run from Sept. 24 to Dec. 20 for ducks and wood cocks. For geese, hunting season runs Sept. 24 to Dec. 31, and Jan. 18 to Jan. 21, 1989.

The daily bag for ducks, the

number of ducks shot in one day, will be limited to six, says Environment Canada. In this tally are included not more than one black duck, one canvasback and one redhead. Regulations also say that a waterfowl shot in error is considered part of the hunter's daily bag.

Possession of ducks cannot exceed 12, according to an Environment Canada regulation. Among those ducks there cannot be more than four black ducks, two canvasback and two redhead.

In order to help the Canadian Wildlife Service gather survey data needed for the management of migratory game bird populations, hunters are asked to keep accurate records of the migratory birds they take, using the form attached to

each \$10 hunting permit.

This information will be requested from a random sample of hunters after the season ends, as part of the 1988 harvest survey. Data obtained will help determine the annual harvest and the status of the duck and goose population in Canada, according to Environment Canada.

Hunters will also be asked to continue the customary practice of leaving at least one feathered wing attached to the bird for identification purposes. "If you don't leave the feathers on, you're open to a charge," said Mr. Sheldon.

But he added that while some people do hunt waterfowl in the Halton Hills area, the nearest large hunting area is on Lake Erie.
