

# Art McReavy receives high scouting honor for work

David Young and Andrew Zubac of 2nd Georgetown Venturer Company delivered a letter to Art McReavy of Weber Drive, Georgetown last Tuesday to inform him he is to receive "The Medal of Good Scouting," for his dedicated service to the 8th Georgetown Cub Pack which was sponsored by the Lions Club and met at St. Francis of Assisi School.

On behalf of the Provincial Board of Honour, Scouts Canada, word was received by Provincial Commissioner Harry Coulson of Mr. McReavy's award. The medal and certificate will be presented at a later date.

Art joined the 8th Georgetown Cub Pack as Assistant Cubmaster in 1978. He then became Cubmaster in 1979 until June 1986 and had a great number of boys during his years of service. He was Service Scouter 1987 to 1988.

Art received his Warrant of Appointment in 1982 and also took his

The 8th Georgetown Cub Pack was very unique when Art had the ability to adapt the program and work with handicapped members. Todd Ellis, Tom Balsillie and Honorary Cub Tracey Coulas for three years.

A real highlight was the "Trailmobile" for Todd designed by Art and built by students of W.J. Wood Secondary School, Mississauga where Art was a shop teacher. This allowed Todd to go on all bikes.

Art has presented "Scouting with the Handicapped" sessions on Woodbadge Training and gave knowledge and confidence to Leaders to take boys into sections.

Senior citizens had the privilege of listening to the Pack sing Christmas carols. Also the boys made crafts for them.

Kub Kar Rallies took on a new twist for 8th Georgetown Cub Pack when they built eight-wheeler trucks one year, then old Jalopies and spaceships to race. Each boy received a trophy every year, handcrafted

by Art. Special programs included a Rodeo Night when everyone had fun.

As the Cubs finished their third year a scrap-book of progress and programs was presented, along with a picture frame of the boy's badges he earned during his stay. "The spirit lives on and memories last a lifetime."

Mr. McReavy feels the help from his assistants and the support of the parents really made everything worthwhile.

Art teaches at Fenton Secondary School in Brampton. Mr. and Mrs. McReavy (Anita) have two sons and a daughter, Ron, Greg and Cheryl. Both boys were in the 8th Georgetown Cub Pack with their dad.

District Commissioner Elaine Hannah was on hand to congratulate Art.

Both David Young and Andrew Zubac were in Art's Cub Pack for three years.
