Vito's is considering postal contract

Chris Bartsch did say the Vitos were given "comfortable time" to review the contract offer. Canada Post chose Vito's Market as a location for postal services after studying several options, said Mr. Bartsch.

But the Vitos could refuse the contract offer if liability demands are too costly, said Mr. Vito. "If it costs three or four thousand for liability, we can't handle it," he said. He added that if the agreement presently being reviewed is a "normal" agreement, he and his wife would sign.

The Vitos said they will give Canada Post their answer within the next few weeks, at which time postal service at the fruit market could begin.

But Canada Post would "look for an alternative" to Vito's if the couple rejects the contract, said Mr. Bartsch.
