Soccer school is funded by the Georgetown Soccer Club and is made available free of charge to any interested child or youth between the ages of six and 21.

Boys and girls will be given the opportunity to practise their skills in mini soccer games which will take up a major part of the training session. Equipment will be provided by the club and parents are advised to provide their children with the type of footwear that will not mark the gym floor. White soled running shoes are preferred. Track suits or shorts and t-shirts are the normal wear for this activity, shin guards are advisable but not mandatory.

There will be separate sessions for different age groups. Boys and girls over the age of 10 will have their own sessions. Boys and girls under 10 will be combined. Separate dressing rooms are

available. Session times are as follows:

10:30 a.m. - 12 noon - Girls over 10. 12 noon - 1:30 - Boys and Girls under 10. 1:30 p.m. - 3 p.m. - Boys under 15. 3 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. - Boys over 15.

Session times may change depending on response during the month of January.

Boys over 15 may be involved in circuit training for stamina building purpose.

Parents and house league coaches who will be involved with the summer season outdoor play are invited to identify themselves and to interact with the session coaches.
