Audubon's treasures on display

A set of Audubon's Bird's of America, worth at leat \$2 million, will soon be nestled in a new home in the basement of the Library of Parliament.

The four-volume collection of colored plates, engraved in England and Scotland between 1826 and 1837, will be the most valuable item in the library's new rare book room. But the Audubon volumes may not be the most important titles destined for the climate-controlled, fire-proof chamber, according to library officials.

There also will be "a very good collection" of memoirs and descriptions of 17th- and 18thcentury Canada written by explorers and historians. They will share shelf space with political pamphlets and tracts from turn-ofthe-century Canada.

"We have a lot of good material on election campaign platforms for the end of the 19th century, beginning of the 20th century," says Michael Graham, head of the collections division.

The oldest book is a 1558 description of New France, replete with protesque drawings of animals.

By the Parliamentary Library's standards, such documents are almost equal in value to the Audubon prints because they deal directly with Canada's past. The library is primarily a resource centre for MPs and senators and the new rare book room will play a part in that.

"There are a lot of pamphlets here of speeches done in the House, speeches done outside the House, so anybody wanting to research free trade, for example, can find it here. It's fundamentally a very

Road repair requested

Cars often left "caked with mud" after a rainstorm have prompted residents of the Fifth Line in Halton Hills to call for repairs to the road.

And after the town grades the road, which is often after a rainfall, the road "is just a solid sea of mud," he said.

In the past, the library's rare book collection was stored under lock and key on the main floor of the library, which stands behind the Centre Block on Parliament Hill. The documents weren't deteriorating but were in peril if a fire occurred.

The 20,000-volume Canadian Pamphlet Collection was languishing under the library's roof in a high-humidity area subject to extremes of heat and cold. Francois LeMay, assistant director of information and technical services, says a special room was needed to protect the collection.

"If we don't keep it in that area, material tends to disappear," he

The specially constructed chamber with concrete block walls has its own independent heating and ventialtion systems. The room is raised off the floor to guard against water damage and is sealed by a metal door with a threehour fire rating.

Instead of sprinklers, the room is

equipped with a Halon gas system. to remove oxygen from the air LeMay says. (without oxygen, fires die).

levels will be controlled and the lights switch off automatically after 30 minues. The whole project will cost about \$135,000, which includes mobile shelving to make the most of limited space.

The room will contain some 430 metres of shelves and house upwards of 9,000 titles ranging from thin pamphlets to multi-volume sets of books. The room is designed to hold future acquisitions and the library is eager to get its hands on political memorabilia from past elections.

"Just as people are asking what was the platform of Laurier at the turn of the century, now they are starting to ask what were the election platforms of parties in the 1970's. We want to protect that

material, even though it doesn't If a fire starts, the gas is released, have a value as rare books,"

The library is hoping Canadian. Humidity and temperature will donate printed documents and other articles from more recent campaigns so the material will be available for future research.

> The core of the current rare-book collection was assembled in the mid-1800's, but its roots go back farther. It was begun by the clerk of the Assembly of Lower Canada who travelled to England and France buying first editions.

> They were lost when the legislature in Montreal, burned to the ground in 1849. The collection was "regenerated" and has moved with Parliament from Montreal to Ottawa by way of Quebec City and Toronto.

> These moves were often made by barge and there are items in the collection bearing waterstains 'rom those nomadic times.
