The familiar Eurailpass, now 36 years old, is back for 1989 in a slightly expanded version at a slightly expanded price.

The so-called pass - actually a prepaid, multinational ticket good for unlimited use during a specified period - costs only about two per cent more than it did a year ago. That's because its basic price is

stated in US funds, and our currency has risen considerably against the Yankee dollar. The basic US price for 1989 is about seven per cent higher than last year's. For 1989, Hungary has joined the network of European nations' railways honoring the Eurailpass. It's the first eastern or Communist-bloc country to join the

list, which includes Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands. Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and West Germany. Another change for pass-holders is the elimination of all special surcharges for fast trains. And the Trans-Europ Express (TEE) all-
