Q. Are you in any way like Peg Bundy?





How to delineate "delineate"




To outline or describe accurately, delineate. For accurate spelling, notice this detail: the line of outline also appears in delineate.

With the mortgage rates jumping around lately, mostly "up", it has set some people into a bit of a tail sping. I've had clients that have started to panic a little, so I thought I might do a little comparison for you, just so you have some figures in your head.

Over the past year, we have been blessed with very low rates of interest on mortgages, the lowest rates we've seen since I have been in the business. So you see, with bad comes good - and I want to be the bearer of good tidings - and I hope this eases your mind a little. So before you panic - give your bank a call, or your real estate agent a call, and check out just what this means to you on a cash flow basis if you are planning on buying a home. The news is not all that bad - and I think we are going to see some nice properties on the market in the next few months - and you can still afford them!
