

# Stars make "Some Enchanted Evening"

Georgetown Globe Production's "Some Enchanted Evening" features five performers who closely resemble many of Rodgers and Hammerstein's leading men and ladies. In addition to its strong chorus, much of the show's strength comes from its five leading performers. All have been singing in theatre for a number of years, and all bring their special talents to this production. Profiled here for you are the real people behind "Anna," "Julie," "Billy," "Nellie," and "Will."

Marlene Johnston hails from Scotland and has been in Canada for 23 years. Growing up surrounded by music, Marlene was encouraged to sing at a young age. Always active in theatre, Marlene joined Globe in 1981 and has been involved in all nine of Globe's major productions. Some of her most memorable roles include the part of Gouch in Mame, and Irene Malloy in Hello Dolly. In Some Enchanted Evening Marlene plays the role of Anna, a woman who can be mysterious and sensual one minute and silly the next. Anna is like the mainstay in the group of five, strong and confident.

Debbie Tilson received her teaching diplomas in voice and piano from the University of Western Ontario's Conservatory of Music. After teaching for 10 years,

Deb plans to start a music program for pre-schoolers this fall. Some Enchanted Evening is Deb's fifth Globe show. Many remember her as Kate, the fiery leading lady in Kiss Me Kate. Deb's most recent role was Minnie Fay in Hello Dolly. Raised in Georgetown, Deb now lives in Rockwood and is enjoying her life in the country. In Some Enchanted Evening Deb plays the role of Julie, an endearingly playful lady whose spunky nature often sneaks out.

Roderick MacIntosh is also a Georgetown native. Roderick studied music locally, reaching Grade 9 voice and Grade 7 piano before heading to Lakefield College to study general sciences. While there, Roderick was a lead singer in Lakefield's production of Noyes Fludde, a story about Noah's Ark. Rod next headed to the University of Western Ontario and while working on his B.A., he continued studying music and appeared in Gilbert and Sullivan's H.M.S. Pinafore. After university, he joined the Gilbert and Sullivan Society of Toronto and in addition to performing in Iolanthe, he operated a sound stage for the performing arts. Rod is glad to be back in Georgetown and is excited about performing with Globe and about his role as Billy, a dazzler, charmer, and lady's man with a keen sense of humor and commanding ways.

Lois Fraser has been an active member of Globe for several years. A talented lady, Lois has her Grade 10 voice and Grade 8 piano. Lois has also studied dance and guitar. Her involvement with Globe has been extensive. Lois was the Arts Alive Committee Chairman for three years, has been a soloist with the Georgetown Choral Society for five years, is a past president, past vice-president, and past treasurer of Globe, and has performed in numerous productions in Brampton, Oakville, London, Ont., and Georgetown, including the leading role of Laurie in Globe's Oklahoma. While doing all this Lois still finds time for other roles as mother of three and as general manager of the Georgetown Terminal Warehouse. Lois' character Nellie is a really fun lady and also a bit of a vamp!

Phil Brennan started doing musicals in high school and has been hooked ever since. Phil joined Globe five years ago and hasn't missed a show yet. He has performed in Li'l Abner, Brigadoon (in the role of Charlie), Stay Tuned, Kiss Me Kate, and most recently as Barnaby Tucker in Hello Dolly. Phil was born in Ireland and raised in Georgetown. He has studied voice, organ, and has been involved with church choirs. While busy learning his music, Phil is working on a degree in Geography at the University of Toronto. Phil's character Will, is a friendly comical performer who fancies himself as a bit of a song and dance man.
