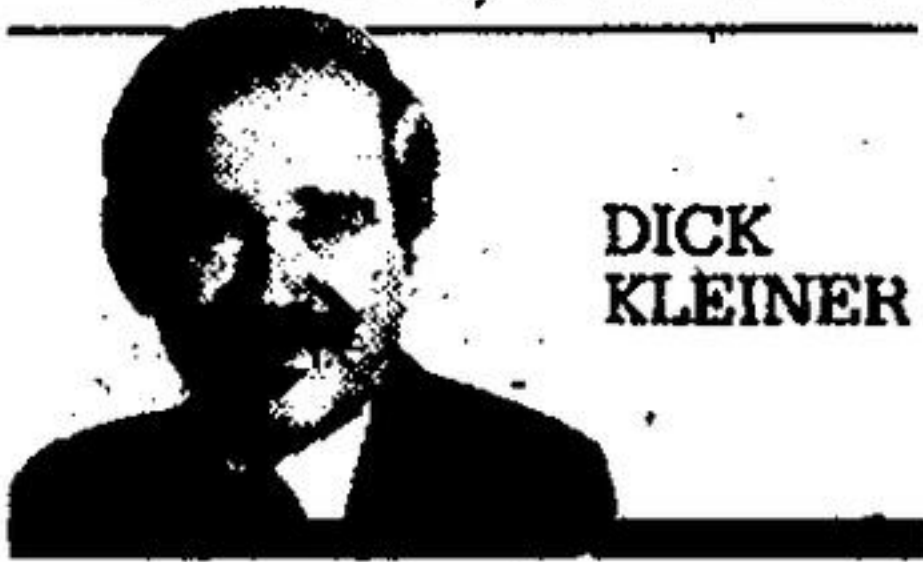

Q. In the movie "Gunsmoke: Return to Dodge" — did James Arness and Amanda Blake actually play in that movie? Has Arness aged that much in 13 years? — P.J.L., Marco Island, Fla.

A. I recently saw the movie "Gunsmoke: Return to Dodge," with James Arness. I was surprised to see Amanda Blake in it. I understood she had cancer and that was why she left "Gunsmoke." — G.B., Muskegon, Mich.

A. Time marches on, and Arness is now 65. He has a craggy face that shows its age. Both he and Amanda Blake — whose cancer is currently in remission — were definitely in that movie.

Tim Finn makes a 'grown-up' video

Thanks to the success of grown-up artists like Steve Winwood and Peter Gabriel, there's actually a market these days for adult rock 'n' roll — a term that was once considered oxymoronic.

Add to the list of intelligent rockers a 36-year-old New Zealander named Tim Finn, founder of '70s pop hopeful Split Enz and big brother of Crowded House's Neil Finn. The new Capitol LP "Tim Finn" promises to revitalize a career that stalled when Split Enz split in '84, and introduce a new audience to this thoughtful, poetic performer.

"The record-buying public seems to be matching my age," says Finn, brushing gray-flecked hair from his face. "The people who buy compact discs, especially, are more in their 30s than their 20s. I may not have much to say to kids of 16 and 17 anymore, but I can say something to a lot of people." Making the new album was a ven-

ture that lasted almost two years, what with demands for Finn to write two film sound tracks and demands for producer Mitchell Froom to do albums for Crowded House and Richard Thompson. Making the video for the premier single "How'm I Gonna Sleep" was equally problematic.

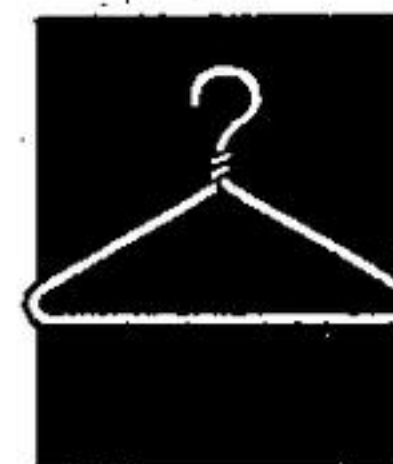
"We were going to shoot in Auckland with a New Zealand filmmaker named Gregor Nicholas. And at the last minute he got the green light for a feature film, so he couldn't do it.

"Capitol said, 'Why don't you do it yourself?' I thought about that for five minutes and said, 'Sure.'"

Now, Finn has never worked as a

director or producer, although he's done the music for five films. But he figured that experience — plus the background of his girlfriend, actress Greta Scacchi (they met when he did the music for her movie "The Coca-Cola Kid") — was a good enough start.

"It was certainly a learning experience," smiles Finn. "The main thing I learned was how specific you must be. If you want a close-up, you have to state exactly how close. You have to learn all the technical language. Because if you don't say precisely what you want, you'll only get an approximation of it."

Don't Get Hung up on Your Hang-ups!

Most draperies can be drycleaned and will come home clean and fresh. (Exceptions are fiberglass, drapes with rubberized backing.) Your drycleaner may have a problem with drapes that have been wet by condensation or rain from an open window. Moisture can cause yellow or brown sizing streaks that can be difficult to remove.

Sometimes draperies come out of cleaning damaged because age and sunlight have degraded the fabric. The weakened areas shred when exposed to the

agitation of cleaning. The pattern of damage on the outside folds, where sun exposure was greatest, is your clue that sun tendering was the cause of the damage.

You can expect draperies to last three years, lined draperies for about five.
