## FLOWER FUN

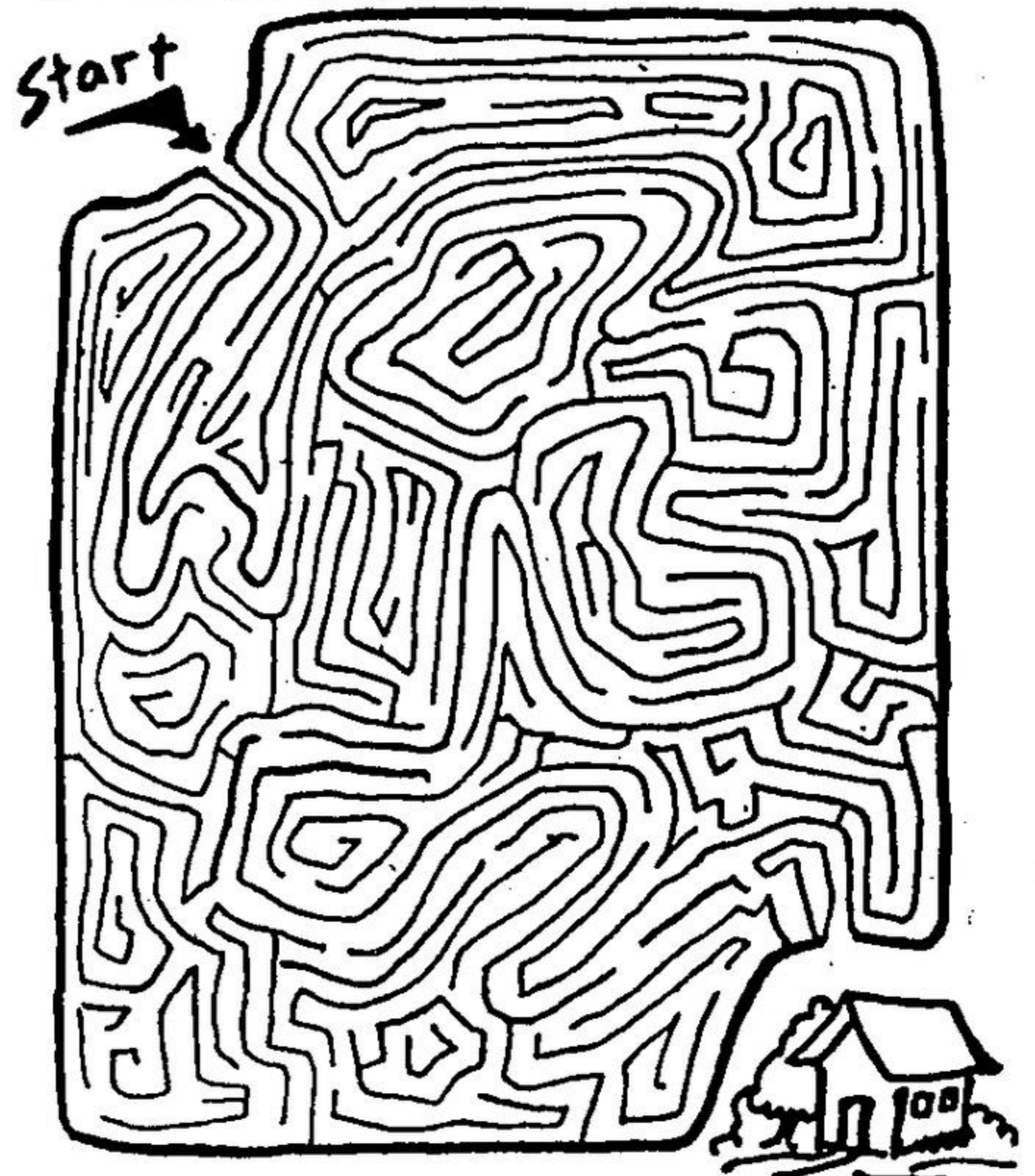

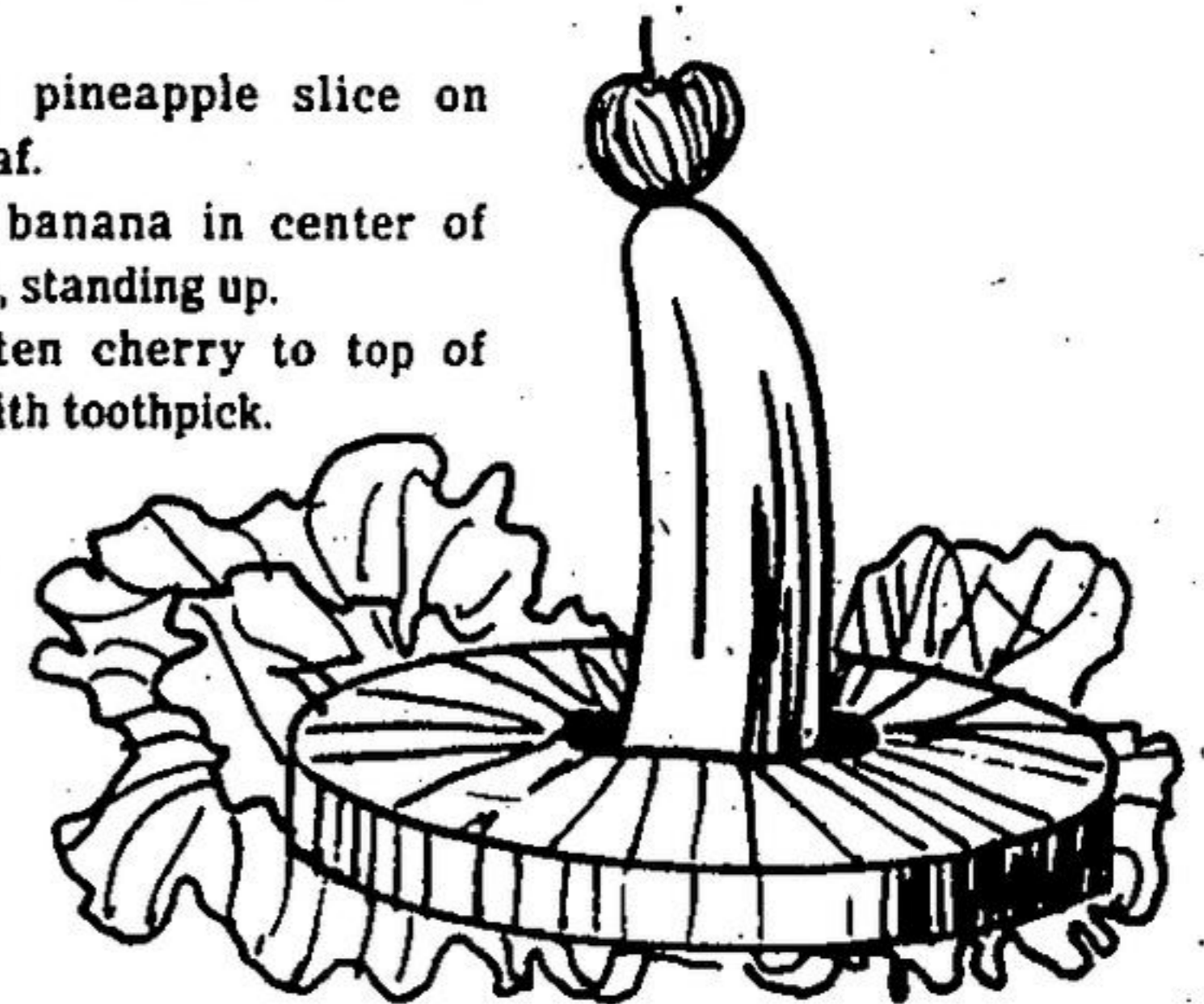
## BUILD A SALAD

| 1 slice of canned pineapple | toothpick    |
| ½ banana                    |              |

**Directions:**

1. Place a lettuce leaf on a plate.
2. Put pineapple slice on lettuce leaf.
3. Set banana in center of pineapple, standing up.
4. Fasten cherry to top of banana with toothpick.
