Ministry modifications mean more rec dollars

TORONTO-Applications under the Community Recreation Development and Community Recreation Capital programs may now be made through Ontario Ministry of Tourism and Recreation regional offices, Minister Hugh P. O'Neil announced recently.

These programs are a consolidation of five separate funding programs. They focus Ministry financial support on four priorities: aging facilities, equal opportunities, coordinated planning, and training and development.

"With better planning, and human resource training and development, all Ontarians will have the chance to become active in a wide range of recreation activities," Mr. O'Neil said. "My Ministry will work with its recreation partners to create a healthier lifestyle throughout the province."

"Recreation is a key to good health and an essential part of a rewarding lifestyle," Mr. O'Neil said. "One quarter of Ontario's health care budget is spent treating preventable diseases. High quality recreation programs reduce these costs by half."

Community Recreation Development will help municipalities and non-profit organizations develop new recreation programs and better manage their services.

Community Recreation Capital will encourage them to protect the value of their existing recreation

facilities, while providing more recreation opportunities for all groups, with an emphasis on disadvantaged people.

The Ministry has simplified its grants process to provide a smoother flow of funds to recreation clients.

The programs which have been consolidated through this process are: Community Recreation Planning, Facility Management, and Wintario Development into the Community Recreation Development program; and Capital Conservation and Capital for New Recreation Facilities into the Community Recreation Capital program.

Ministry clients who were eligible for the five programs will continue to be under the Community Recreation Development and Community Recreation Capital programs.

The Ministry held regional meetings with its recreation clients in 1988. The ideas that flowed from those meetings were considered in the Ministry's restructuring of its financial support programs.

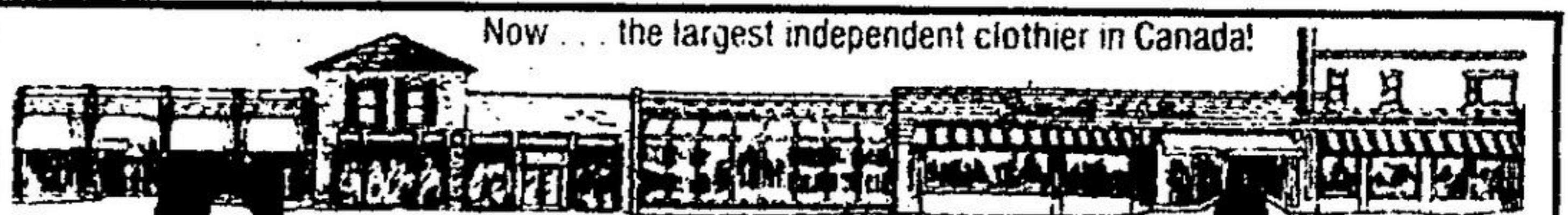

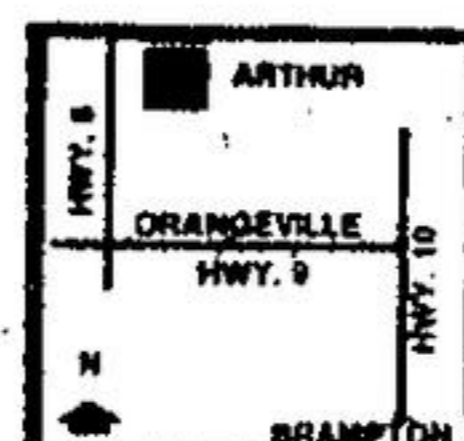
