'Ancient Chinese philosophers devised complex functional inter-relationships between Nature and Man. This yin/yang system explained the balanced harmony of complementary antagonists: 'active, quiet; bright, dark; hot, cool; health, disease. The metaphor of the Five Phases (wood, fire, earth, metal and water) was said to represent the whole of Nature and Man simultaneously. By understanding the components of this harmony of opposites, early Chinese physicians diagnosed and treated illness in ways that today's Western practitioners find bizarre and naive.

While modern scientists may alternately scoff and marvel at these complicated machinations - which were quite detailed and doctrinaire there is much we don't appreciate or understand about how and why people become sick. External factors certainly play a role, but how much? The mind, too, surely is a mysterious and

emotional stimuli can cause allergic reactions, in a sort of Pavlovian scheme. This finding has the potential to revolutionize the management of many allergic diseases, including rhinitis (hay fever), asthma, food sensitivities. Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis. The experimenters used rats. Ini-

tially, the rodents were injected with egg albumin (a foreign protein) and exposed to flashing lights and a whirring fan. During the first portion of the experiment, the scientists documented the production of immunoglobulin E antibodies as a reaction to albumin, thereby demonstrating thatan actual allergic event had taken place.

After several training sessions, the rats produced antibodies from the stimulation of the lights and fan only; no albumin was needed. The conclusion: Mucosal mast cell release of mediators is subject to central nervous system modulation, meaning that the animals developed full-blown allergies from sight/sound brain stimulation. Although further work is needed to prove this relation in humans, it is intriguing to consider that folklore such as getting hives from anxiety may be correct.

If further studies confirm the Canadian findings, scientists may conclude that certain allergies are related to emotional upset, tension and stress. More important, if the body's reactions can be turned on by conditioning, why can't they be turned off?
