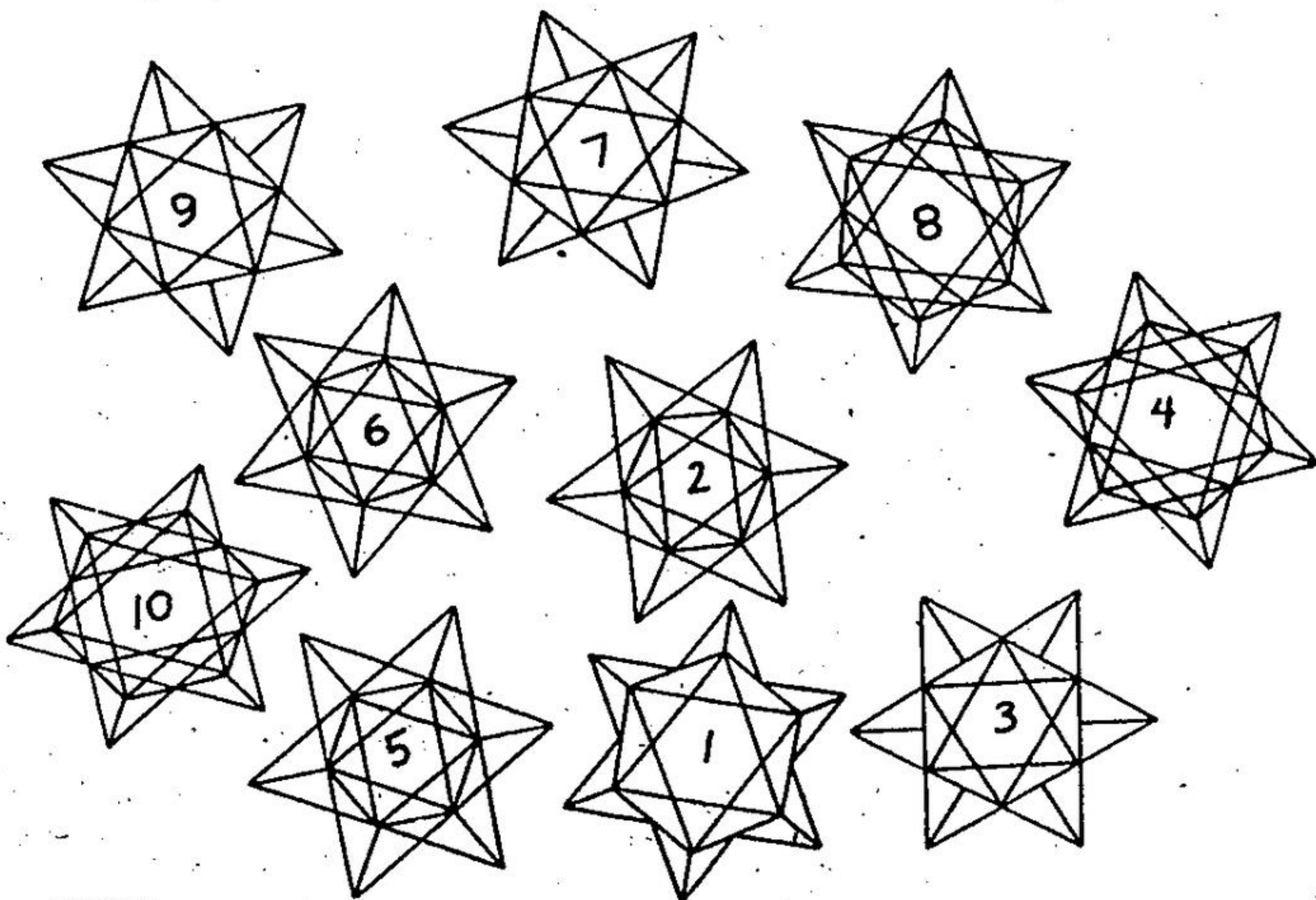

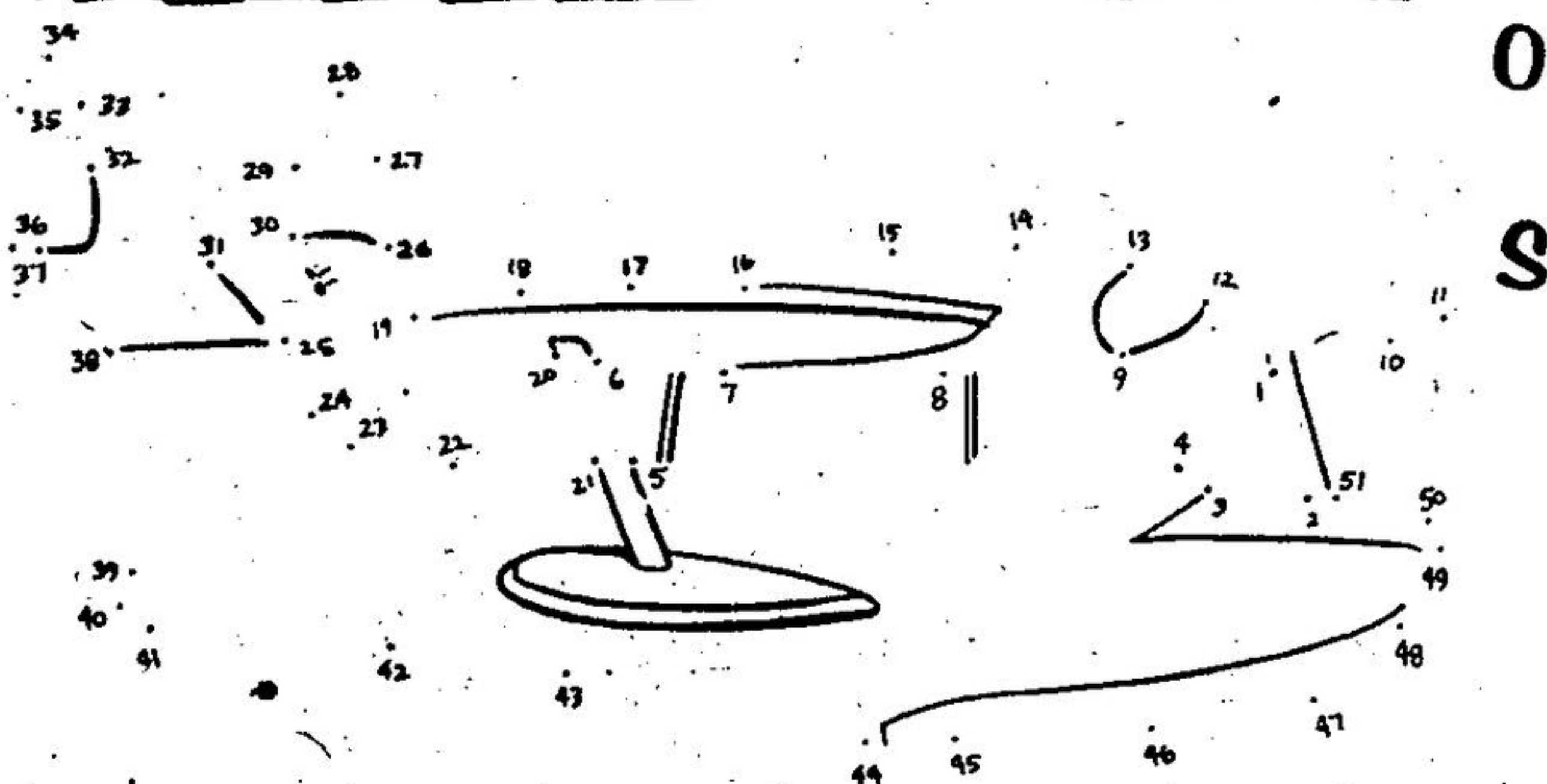
TWINKLE TWINKLE LITTLE STAR



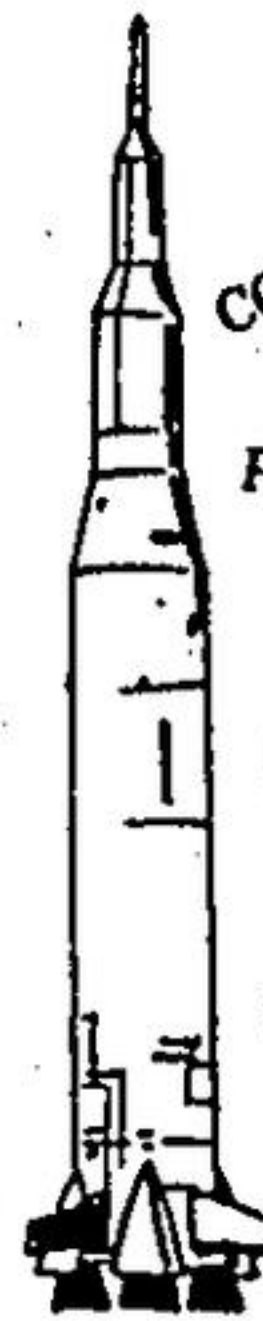

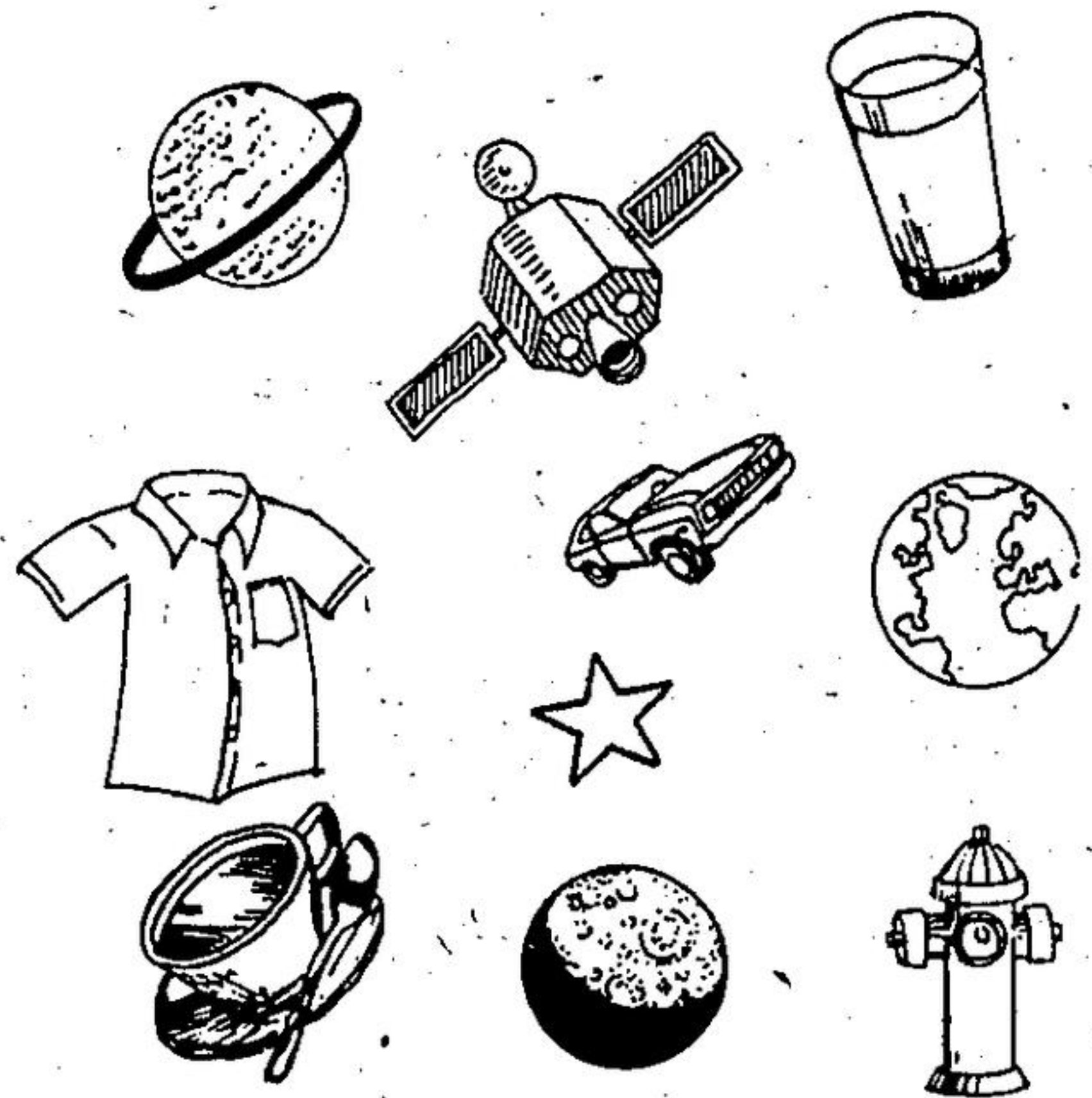
