


TWINKLE TWINKLE LITTLE STAR




Connect the dots to find the vehicle that is used to rescue astronauts from emergency landings in water, forests, deserts or jungle areas.

B. The next brightest planet.


C. Planet with a reddish tinge.

E. At certain times of the year, it appears low in the sky just before sunrise.


