defense took two more heart tricks to set the contract.

This deal is an exercise in avoidance. To protect his J-9 of hearts, declarer must strive to keep East off lead until the contract is secure. Therefore, declarer should lead to the 10 of diamonds in dummy and come off with a low club. East will duck, and South wins the queen. Playing a second club would now be a mistake. Instead, declarer goes to dummy with the diamond king and plays a low spade. Once again, if East rises with the ace, declarer will have nine tricks. So East plays the nine and declarer wins the spade queen. Now he can switch back to clubs and guarantee making his contract.

And what if West could have won the ace of spades? He would have led back a spade, but declarer could not



The nine lost to West's 10, and West cleared the heart suit. Now the queen of clubs disclosed the bad news. So South went to dummy with the king of diamonds to play a low spade. East rose immediately with the ace, and the


