4. Alfie likes his feathered friends, but Linda likes animals with antlers.

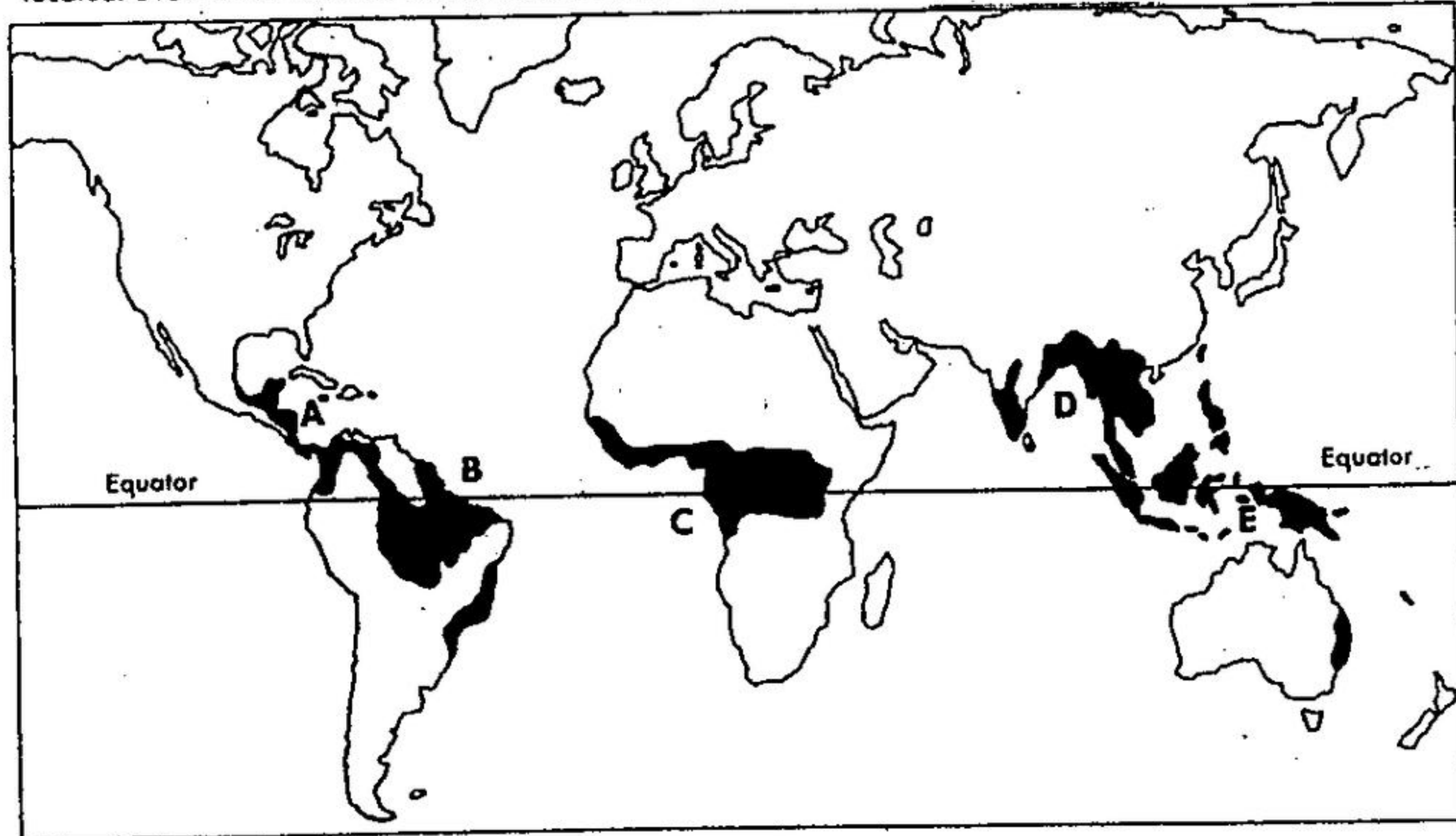

RAIN FOREST FINDER

A tropical rain forest is a forest of very tall trees in an area where it rains a great deal and is warm all year long. These forests are near the equator, an imaginary line that divides the earth into the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere. The darkened area of the world map shows where the tropical rain forests of the world are located. Draw a line from the names of these areas written below the map to the correct darkened location.

1. A tropical rain forest has more kinds of trees than any other part of the world. In one 2 1/2-acre area in South America, scientists counted 179 species of trees.

2. At least 80 inches of rain fall every year in a tropical rain forest. There may be thundershowers more than 200 days a year.

3. Many animals that live in a tropical rain forest spend their entire lives in the trees and never come down to the ground.

4. The sun shines about 12 hours a day at the equator. At the edges of the tropics, daylight lasts about 10 1/2 hours a day in the winter to

about 13 1/2 hours a day in the summer.

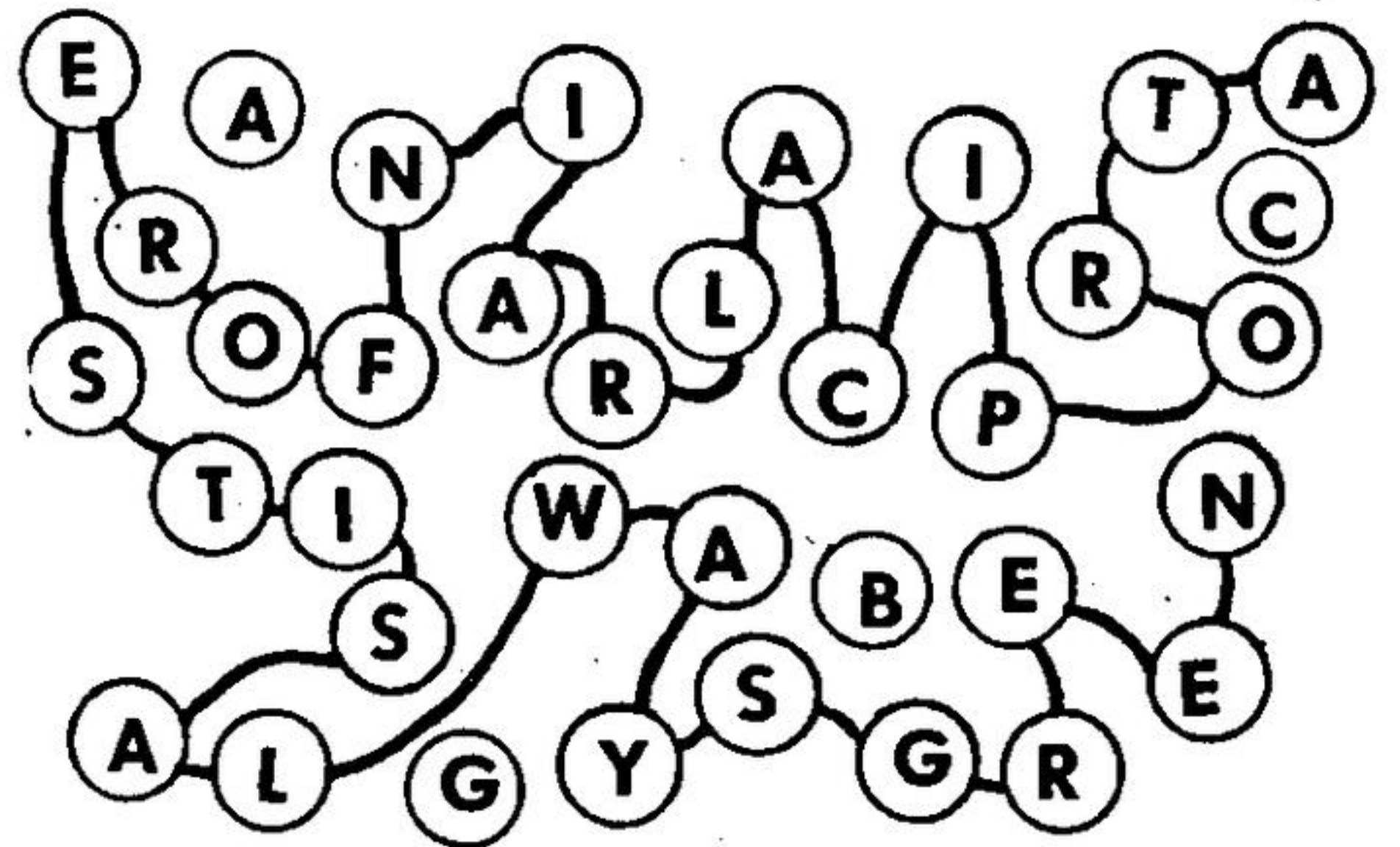
5. The gibbon, a member of the ape family, is considered the most agile of all mammals in the trees. The generic name of the six gibbon species is *Hylabates*, which means "dweller in the trees."

6. The tallest trees in a rain forest may grow as tall as 200 feet.
