# Norval dropped from league's schedule

Standings in the league's "B" Division tightened considerably as a result of Sunday's games in the Georgetown Men's Flag Football League.

Longhorns manhandled M and M, 46-7; Corrigan embarrassed Kerry Kitchens, 48-7; Plus Welding got past the Oldtimers, 21-6 and Dairy Queen shook off a gritty Glen squad, 16-12.

Muscle Works was awarded a 6-0 win over Norval, who defaulted for the third consecutive game because of a lack of player. According to a league spokesman, Norval will be dropped from the league and decisions regarding points will be discussed at a league meeting. Game times will be adjusted accordingly as a result of the Norval banishment.

The league takes this weekend off, with games resuming Aug. 13, at the Georgetown high school football field.

Whether it was overconfidence or simply a matter of the offence not humming on all cylinders, Dairy Queen was lucky to escape with a 16-12 win over the Glen. The Glen shouldn't be taken lightly, however, as they are solidly in second spot in the league's "B" Division and could pull some surprises come playoff time.

The game was knotted, 6-6 at the half, with kickers Jeff Lockwood of Dairy Queen and Sean McQuarrie of the Glen, trading a pair of field goals.

The Glen jumped in front, 12-6 early in the second half when quarterback, Howie Jacobs, connected with Mike Henderson for a major. The convert was wide.

Dairy Queen sucked it up at that point and a touchdown by Randy

Lunn, converted by Jeff Lockwood, plus a Lockwood field goal, sealed the win.

Plus Welding unveiled their secret weapon against the Oldtimers and perhaps the sight of Joe Frost performing kicking duties was too much for the eventual losers.

Marcus Noel, Dan MacIntosh and Don Turner scored the Plus Welding majors, with Frost successfully kicking three converts.

(According to league sources, there is no truth to the rumour that Frost will be getting a haircut and attempting to replace the Argos inconsistent Lance Chomyc.)

Bill Fournier scored the Oldtimers' six points.

Brad Ferguson had a field day against Kerry Kitchens, scoring 20 points on three majors and a two-point convert.

The game was virtually decided by halftime, with Corrigan out in front, 24-7.

Diminutive Al Pelland had another strong game for the winners, scoring two touchdowns. Kevin Brown and Mike DelGuidice also had majors for Corrigan with Linas Stasinlis chipping in with two points on a two-point conversion.

Scott Murray scored the Kerry Kitchens touchdown, with Anthony Oram converting.

Longhorns rode the strong arm of quarterback Mike McCandless and the equally strong right hoof of Davey Paterson, in subduing M and M, 46-7.

Longhorns led 20-7 at the half and their impressive defensive unit squelched any second half M and M hopes.

Paterson collected 10 points Sunday, on a field goal, five converts

and two singles. The single points were garnered off kickoffs and all M and M could do was watch helplessly as the moonshots landed in bounds then trickled through the end zone.

Paul Allison had 18 points for the winners, Mark Hamilton scored two touchdowns and Wayne Dole rounded out the scoring with a major.

Brian King scored the lone M and M touchdown, with Simon Golding converting.

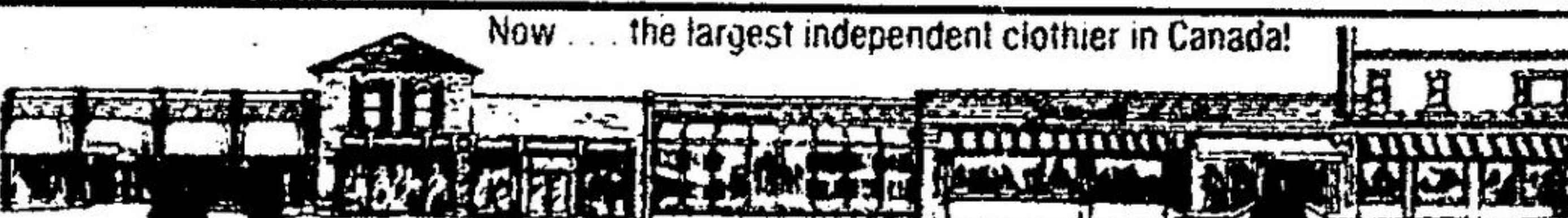

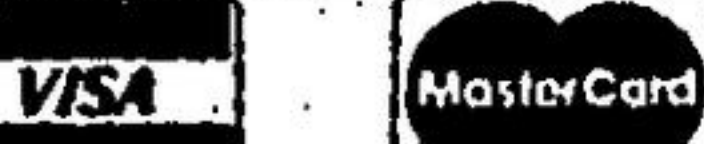
