### Community groups can rent old town offices

The Halton Hills town administration building on Trafalgar Road - now replaced by the spanking new Civic Centre off Maple Avenue - will be used for renting space to community groups, councillors decided Tuesday night.

Following a meeting that took Halton Hills town council past 11:30 p.m., including an in-camera session, town council voted to rent space on a "short term, month to month basis," said town clerk Delmar French.

The property, located north of Maple Avenue on Trafalgar Road has been vacant since council began to meet in the new council chambers on Princess Anne Drive. Occupancy in the old quarters will be on an "interim" basis. The property will be rented to community-based groups, Mr. French said.

Maintenance and administration of the building will be taken care of by the town's recreation and parks department.
