"Shadowland" could be repeat country winner

The shadow of the 1988 Canadian Country Music Awards is hanging over the 1989 awards.

Alberta's K.D. Lang walked off with three awards last year, including the top prize, Entertainer of the Year. She was also chosen as the top female vocalist and received the award for album of the year for Shadowland.

She is a finalist in four categories this year, including album of the year. And the album CCMA members much...Shadowland.

The fact the album that won last is among this year's nominees is not an indication of a scarcity of top country albums, CCMA president Paul Mascioli said in a telephone interview from Ottawa. "The membership feel it is such a strong album, it deserves another shot at it this year."

Shadowland is eligible again because it meets the time-frame requirements set by the CCMA. There is a two-month overlap each year. Records released in a 14month period. April 1 of one year to May 31 of the following year, are eligible. Records released in April or May can be nominated in two consecutive years -- but it is fairly rare. A record released just before nominations close has to be an ins-

tant hit to attract enough attention for CCMA members to vote for it.


