
### THE ENGLISH SEA DOG

Sir Francis Drake, an explorer in the 1500s, was the first Englishman to sail around the world. He fought against the Spaniards, the main rivals of the English, and helped England become a major sea power.

Drake was the most famous of the sea captains who roamed the oceans during Queen Elizabeth I's rule. The captains who raided Spanish shipping were called sea dogs. Today, any experienced sailor is called a sea dog.

Drake's ship, the Golden Hind, has been rebuilt. The sailors who sail it now wear clothes like the original sailors of the 1500s.
