Crossing guards hired

Acton Councillor Gerald Rennie reacted with surprise to a Halton Hills recommendation to put two crossing guards at Georgetown intersections.

"Surely one crossing guard with a huge stop sign is sufficient," Coun. Rennie said of the intersecat Delrex Boulevard and Mountainview Road and Moore Park Crescent and Main Street.

The councillor said he is familiar with both intersections, and does not see a safety problem that would warrant doubling the town's costs.

He asked if the town would like a "row" of crossing guards. He added that the crossing guard stands the middle of the road until children cross. Children are not led

across "like ducks."

But town engineer Bob Austin said crossing guards have refused to go out in the street when they think it could be dangerous. The glare from the sun blinds some drivers, Mr. Austin said.

"People have to stand out there in front of these moving vehicles. (An extra crossing guard) may be a small price to pay."


Town staff completed a report after hearing that there were several near-accidents involving pedestrians at the two Georgetown intersections.






