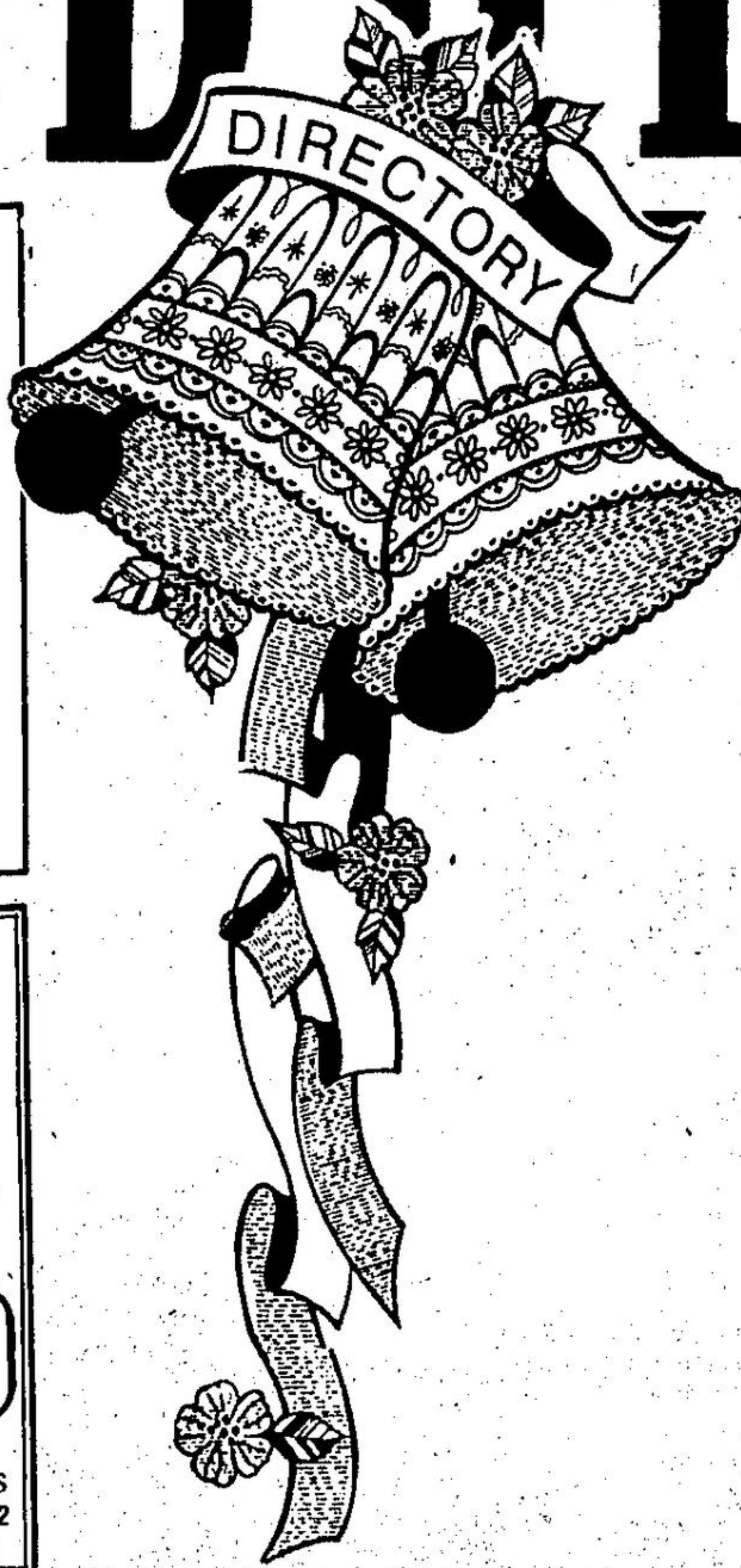
## Parking lot for commuters in Milton
